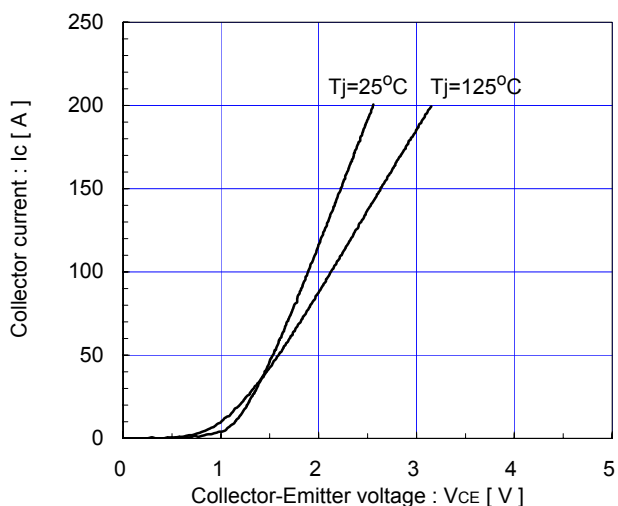
Collector current vs. Collector-Emitter voltage (typ.)  
T<sub>j</sub>=25°C / chip



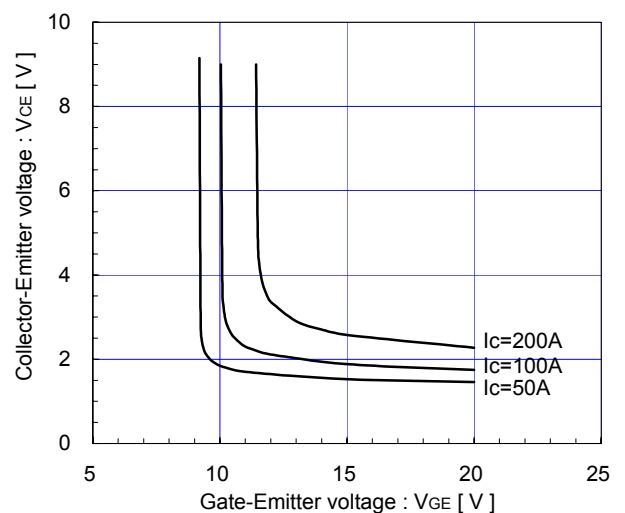
Collector current vs. Collector-Emitter voltage (typ.)  
T<sub>j</sub>=125°C / chip



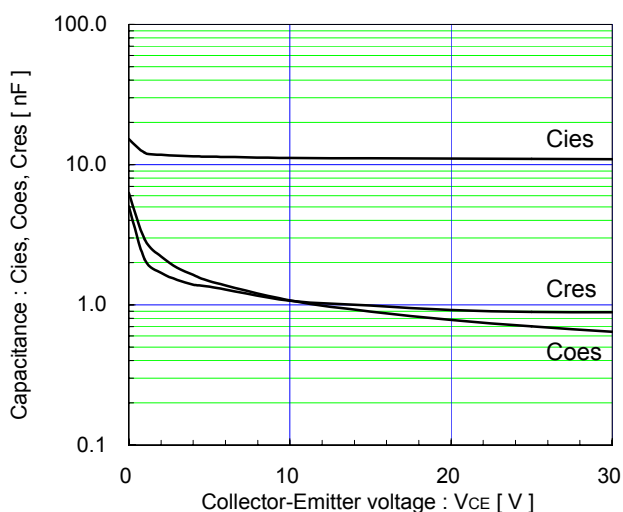
Collector current vs. Collector-Emitter voltage (typ.)  
V<sub>GE</sub>=15V / chip



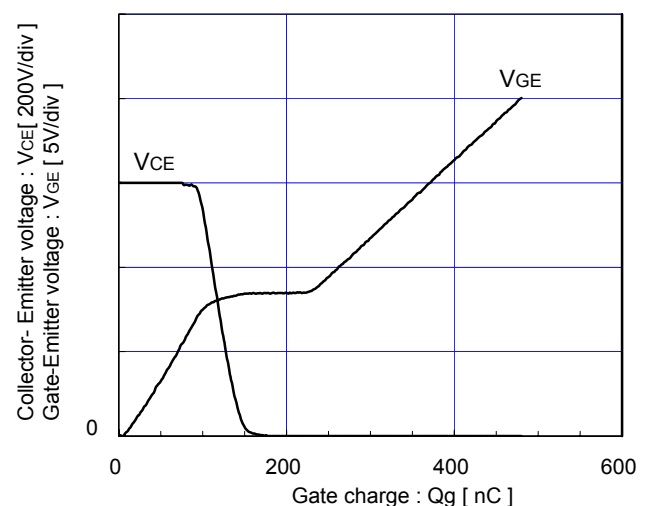
Collector-Emitter voltage vs. Gate-Emitter voltage (typ.)  
T<sub>j</sub>=25°C / chip



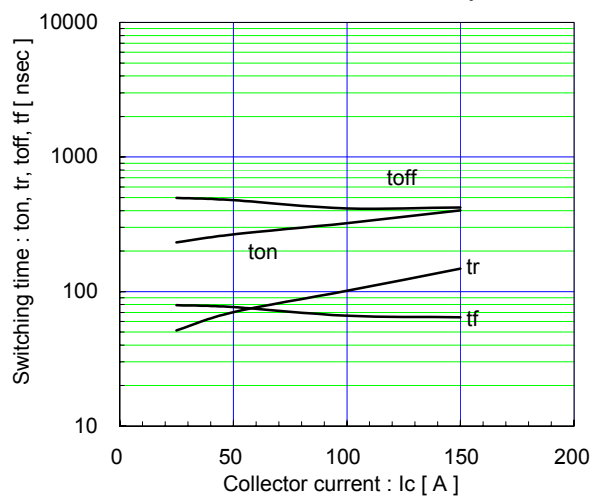
Capacitance vs. Collector-Emitter voltage (typ.)  
V<sub>GE</sub>=0V, f=1MHz, T<sub>j</sub>=25°C



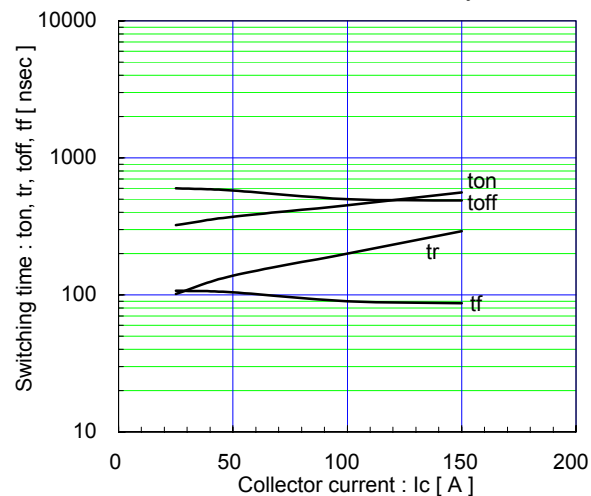
Dynamic Gate charge (typ.)

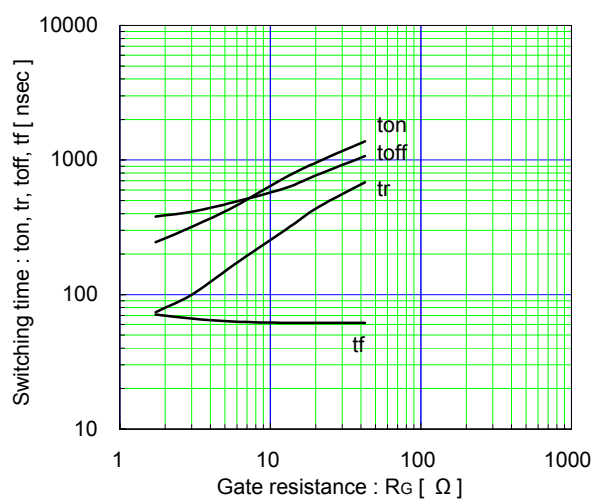
Switching time vs. Collector current (typ.)

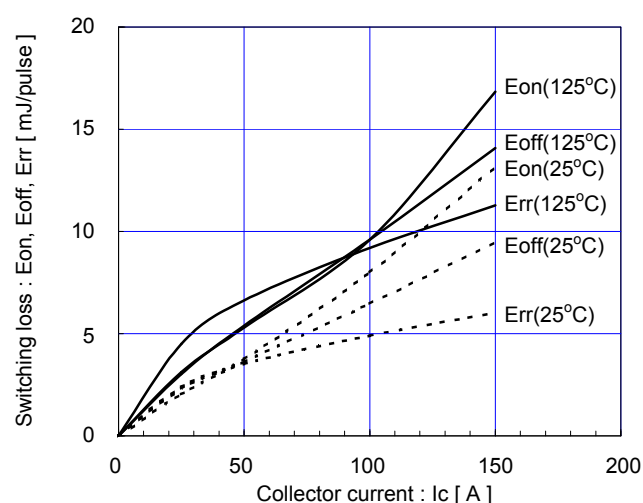
Switching time vs. Collector current (typ.)

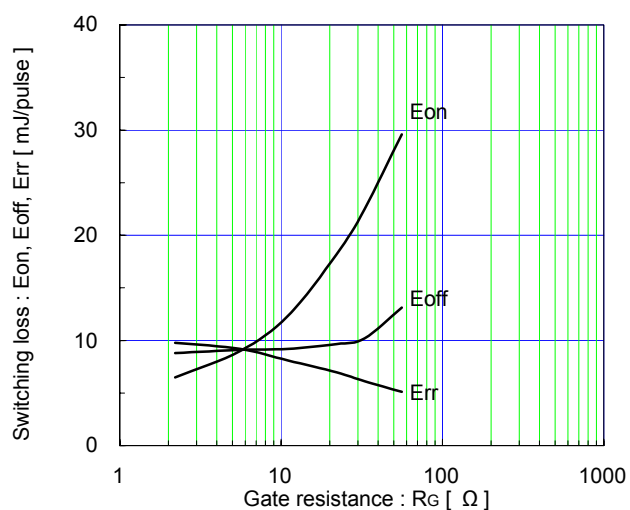
Switching time vs. Gate resistance (typ.)  
 $V_{CC}=600V$ ,  $I_C=100A$ ,  $V_{GE}=\pm 15V$ ,  $T_J=25^\circ C$



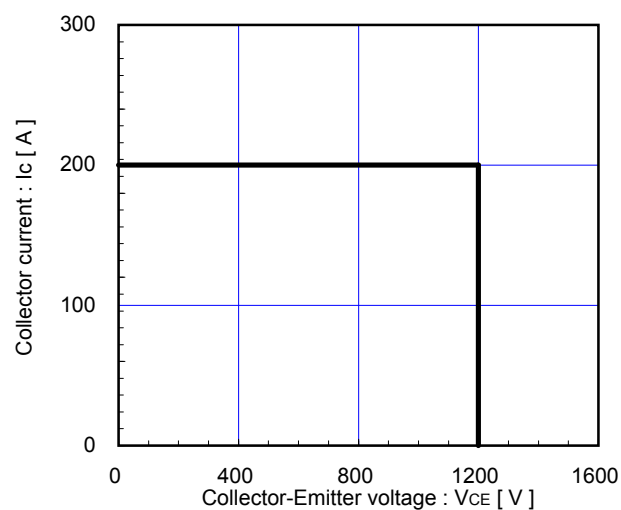
Switching loss vs. Collector current (typ.)

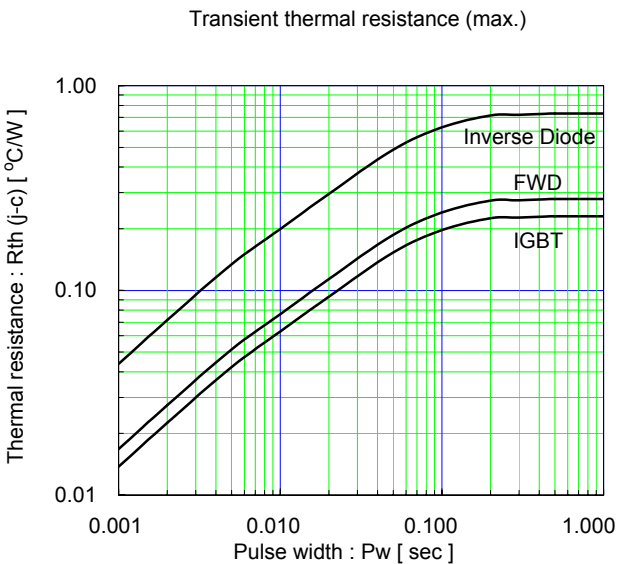
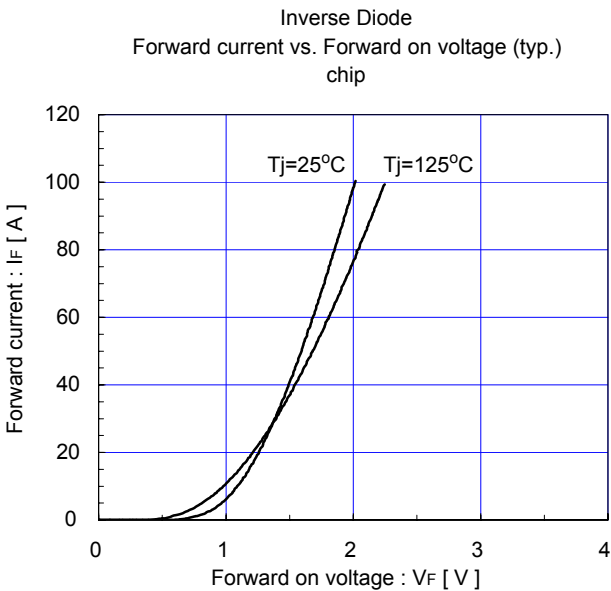
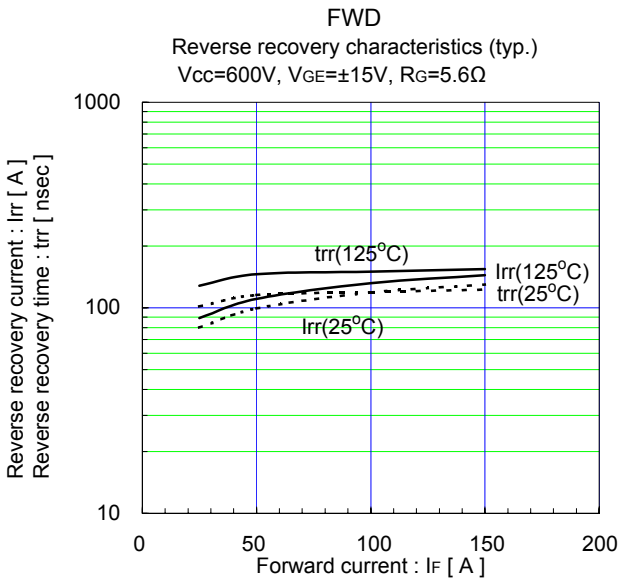
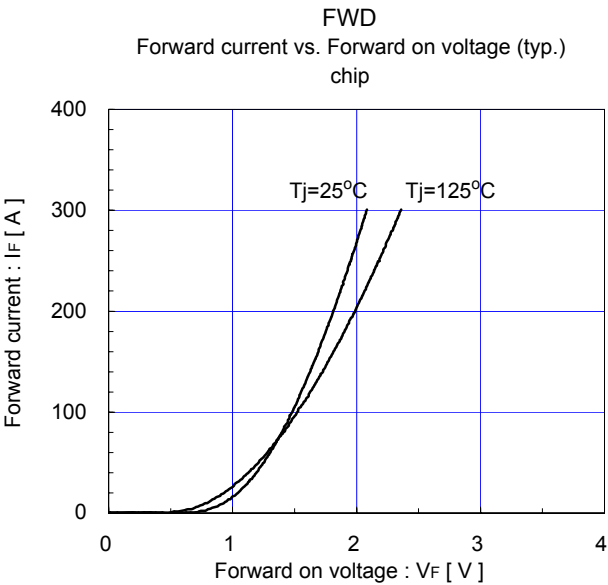


Switching loss vs. Gate resistance (typ.)

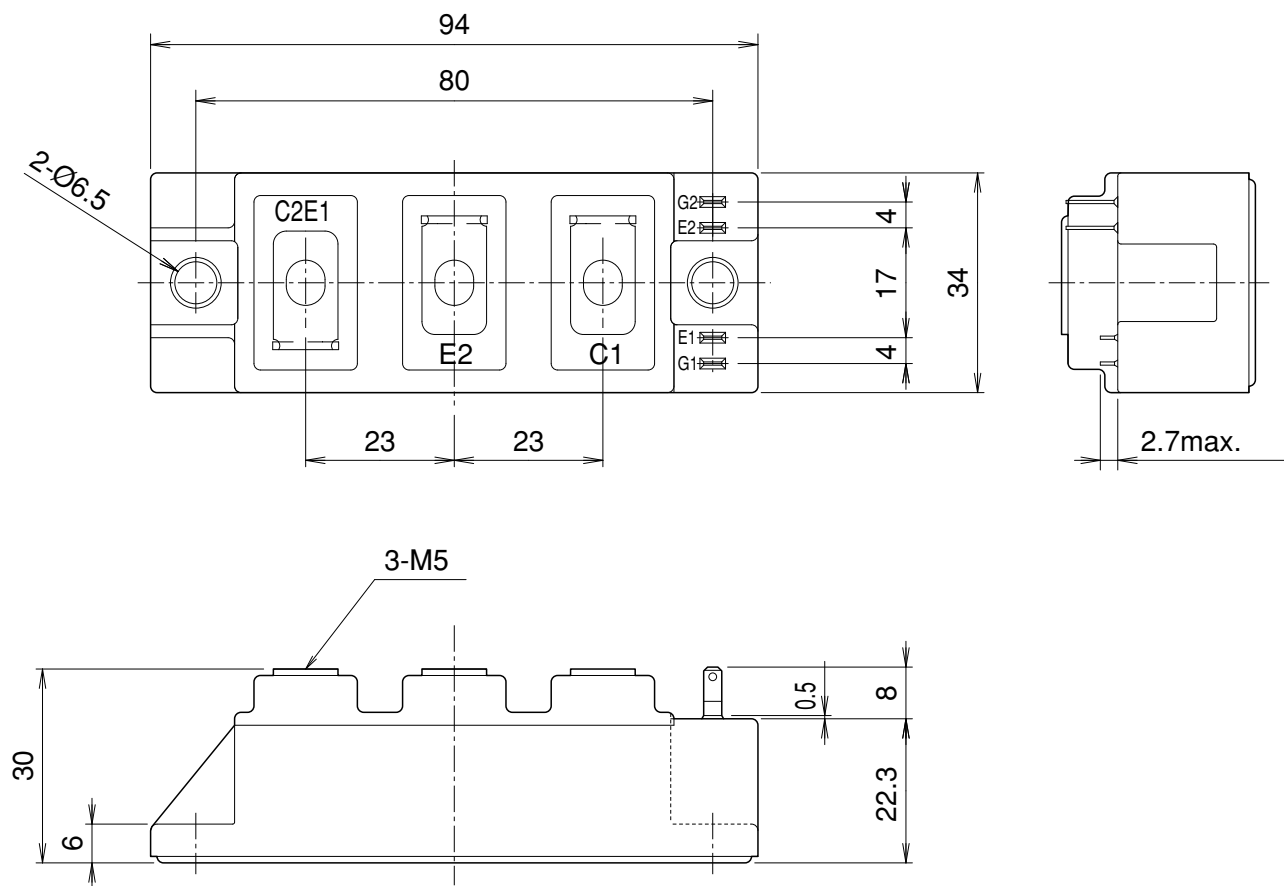


Reverse bias safe operating area (max.)

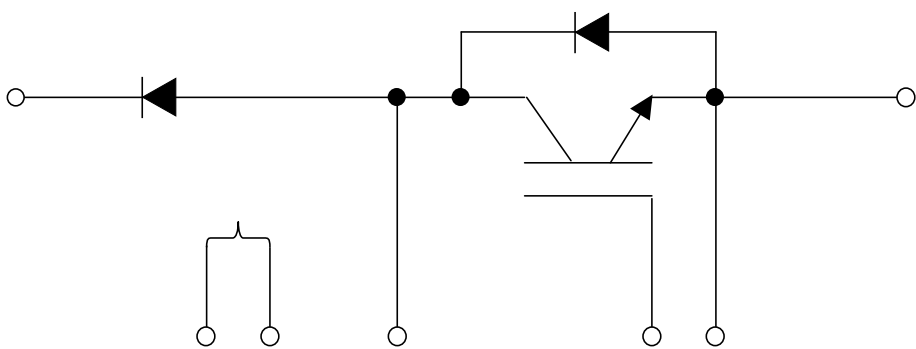
