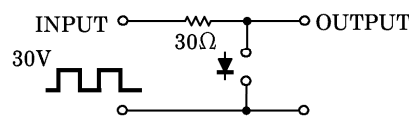
Note 1 : t_{rr} TEST CIRCUIT



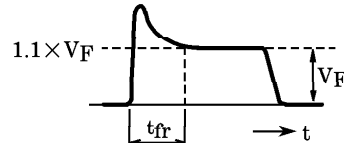

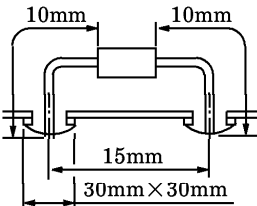
Note 2 : t_{fr} TEST CIRCUIT

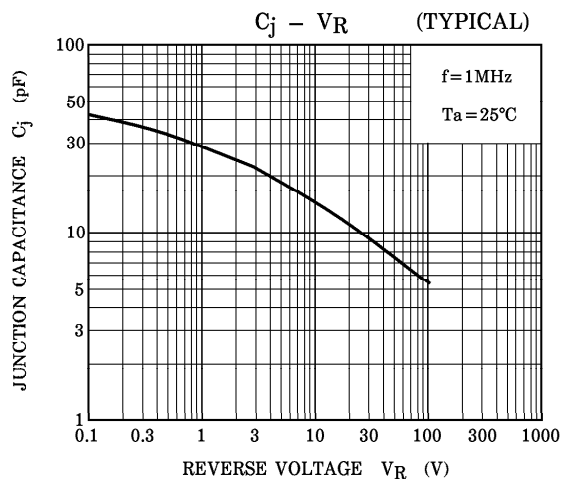
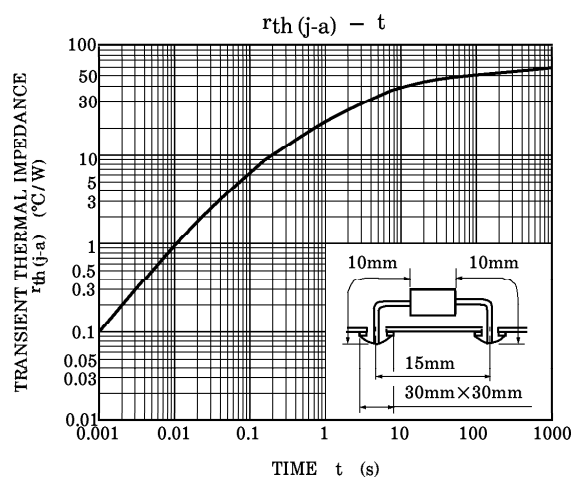
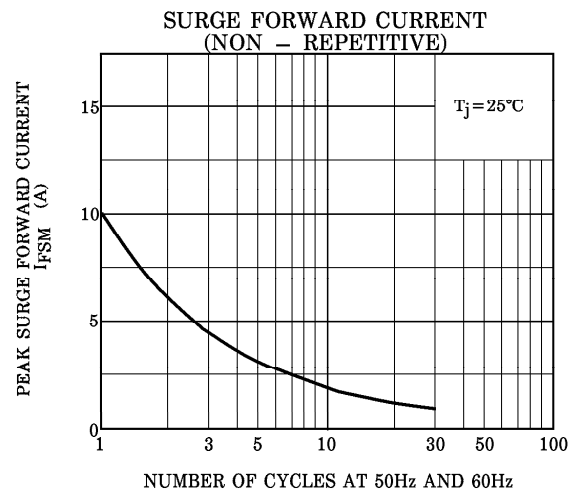
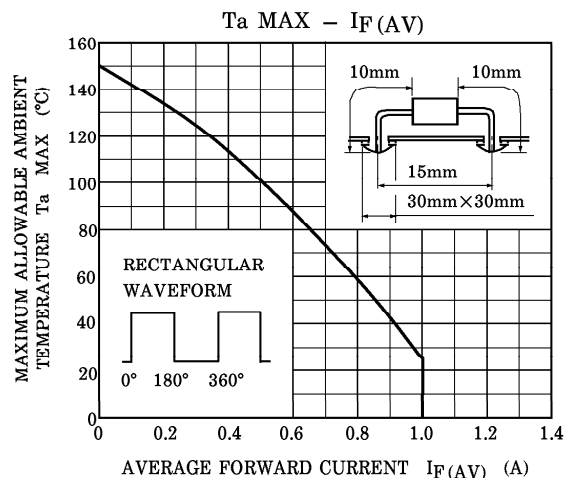
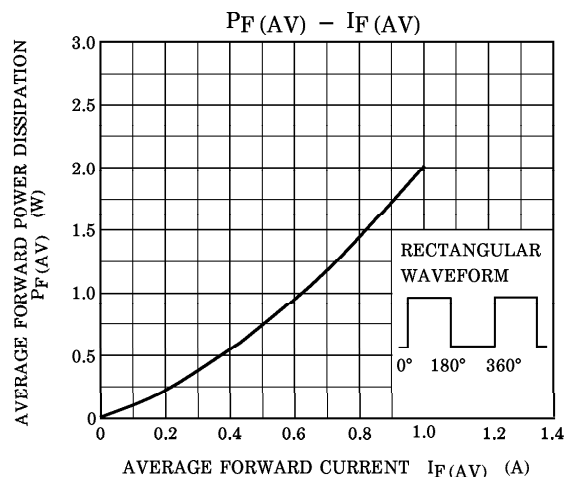
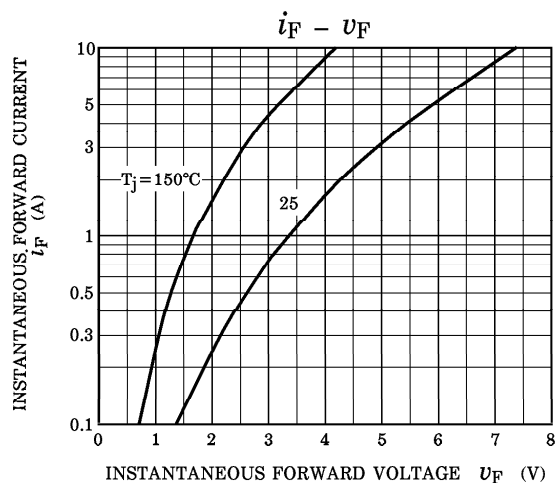


Note 3 : THERMAL RESISTANCE



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
