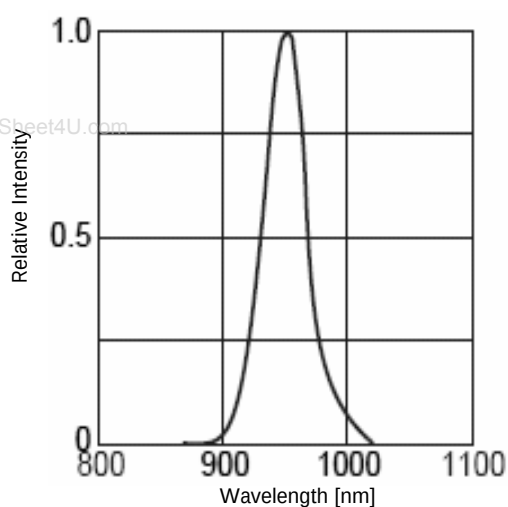

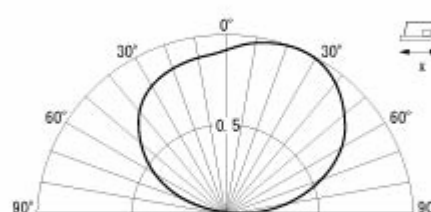

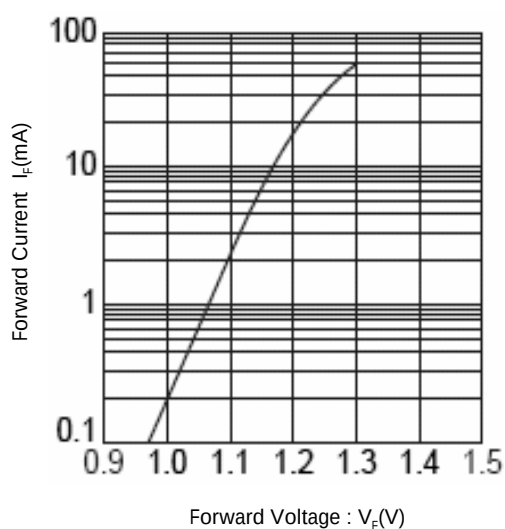


Spatial Distribution Example

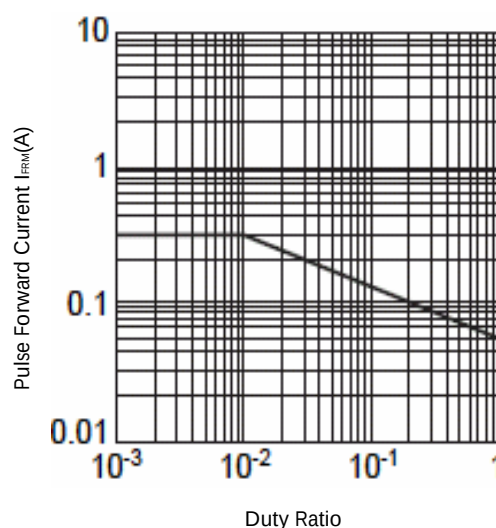

Condition : $T_a = 25^\circ\text{C}$

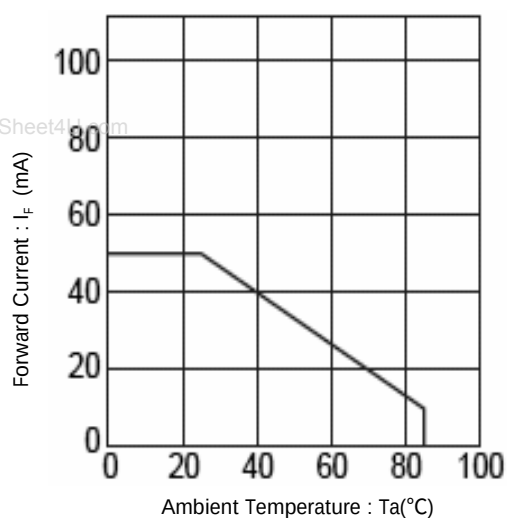


Duty Ratio vs. Pulse Forward Current
Condition : $T_a = 25^\circ\text{C}$, $t_w \leq 100 \mu\text{s}$



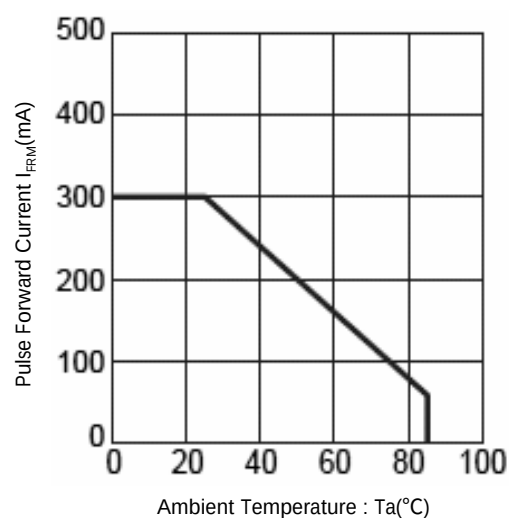

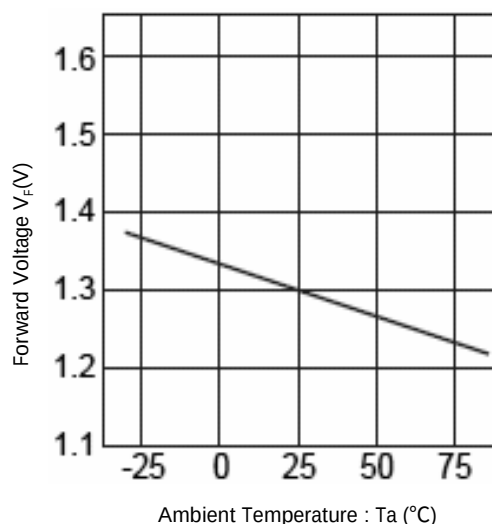
Ambient Temperature vs. Pulse Forward Current

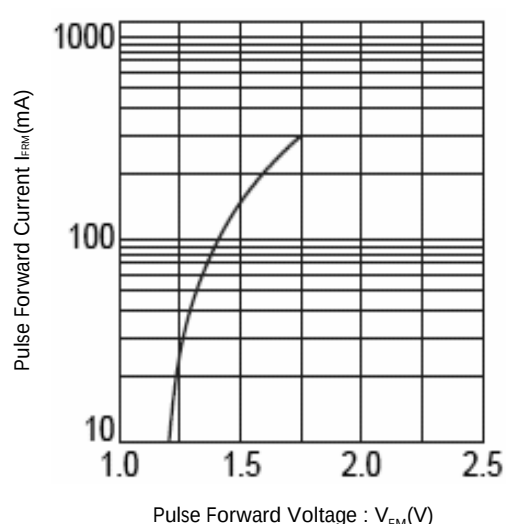
Ambient Temperature vs. Forward Voltage

Pulse Forward Voltage vs. Pulse Forward Current

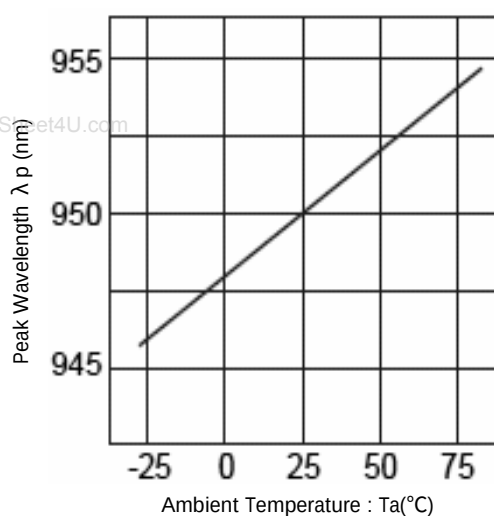

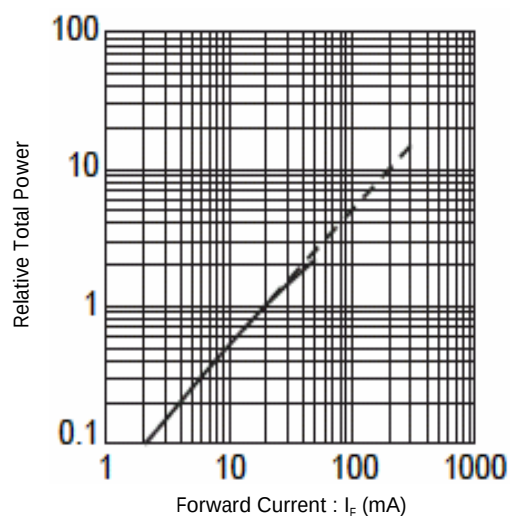

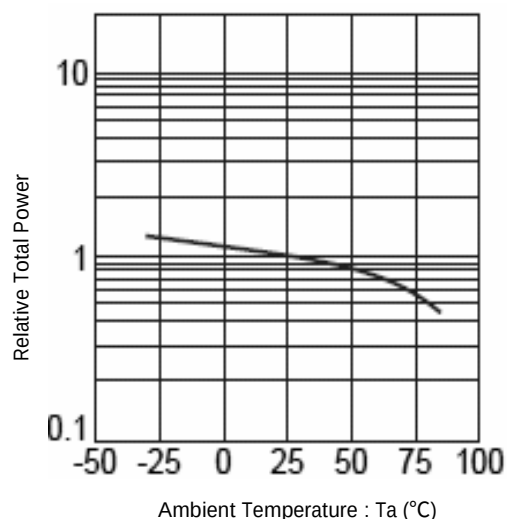
Ambient Temperature vs. Peak Wavelength

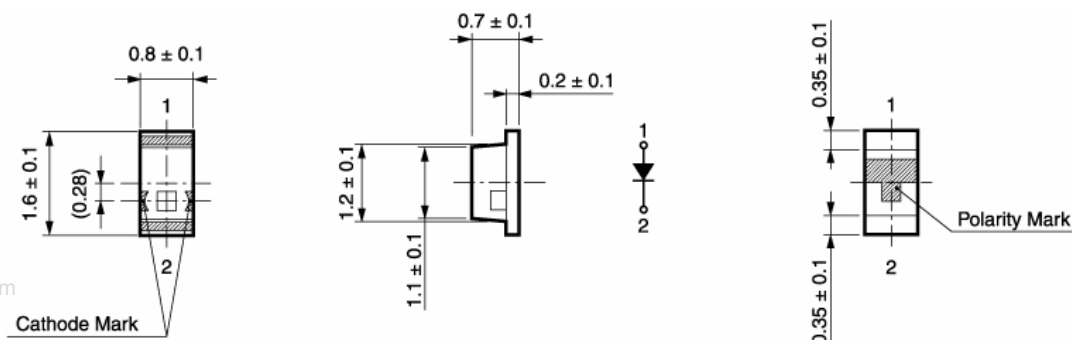
Ambient Temperature vs. Relative Total Power

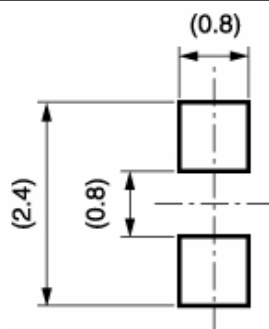

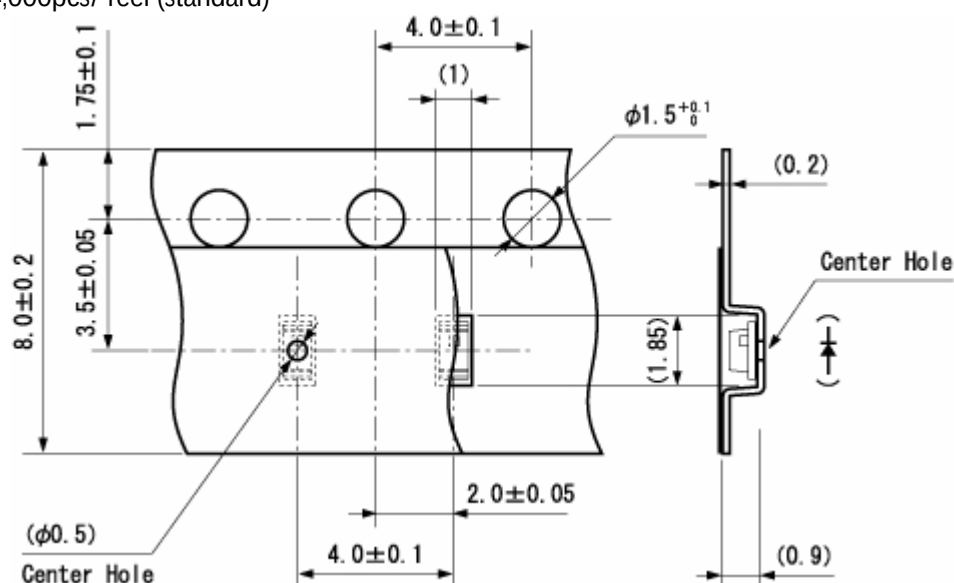

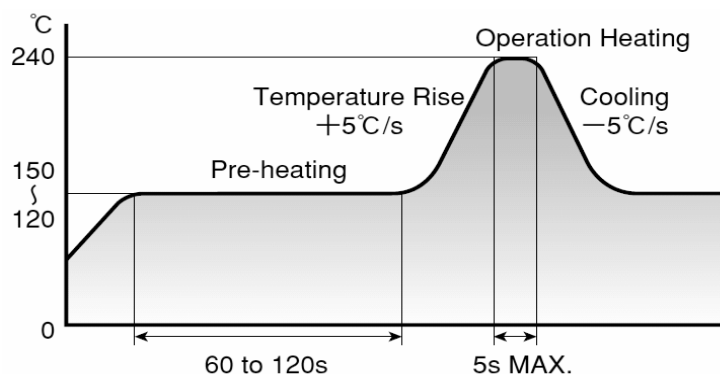

Reflow Soldering Conditions



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- 1) The above profile temperature gives the maximum temperature of the LED resin surface. Please set the temperature so as to avoid exceeding this range.
- 2) Total times of reflow soldering process shall be no more than 2 times. When the second reflow soldering process is performed, intervals between the first and second reflow should be short as possible (while allowing some time for the component to return to normal temperature after the first reflow) in order to prevent the LED from absorbing moisture.
- 3) Temperature fluctuation to the LED during the pre-heating process shall be minimized.

TTW (Through The Wave) soldering Conditions

Pre-heating	120°C~150 °C (MAX.) 60 s ~120 s (MAX.)
Solder Bath Temp.	260 °C (MAX.)
Dipping Time	5 s (MAX.)

- 1) The dip soldering process shall be 2 times maximum.
- 2) The product shall be cooled to normal temperature before the second dipping process.
