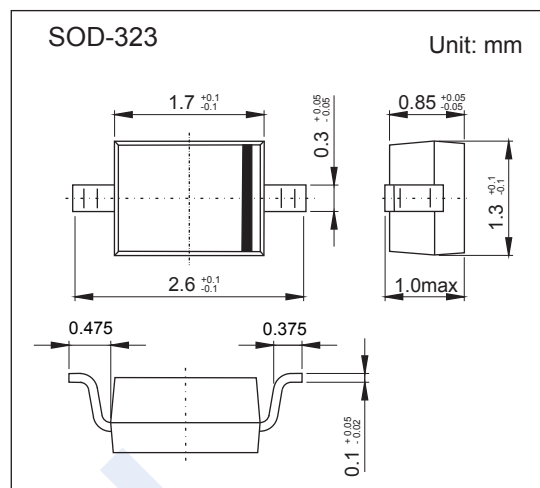

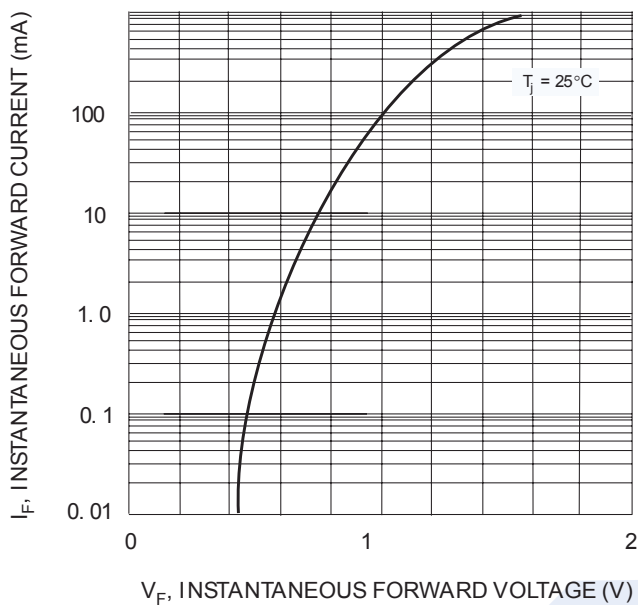


Fig. 1 Forward Characteristics

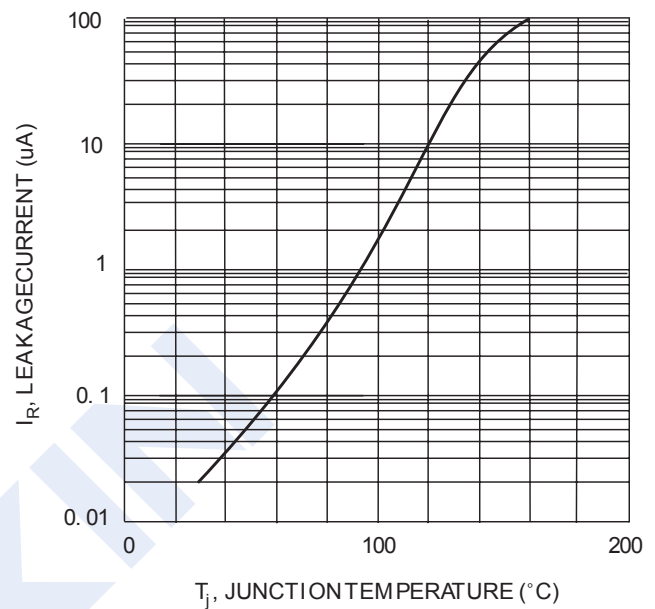


Fig. 2 Leakage Current vs Junction Temperature
