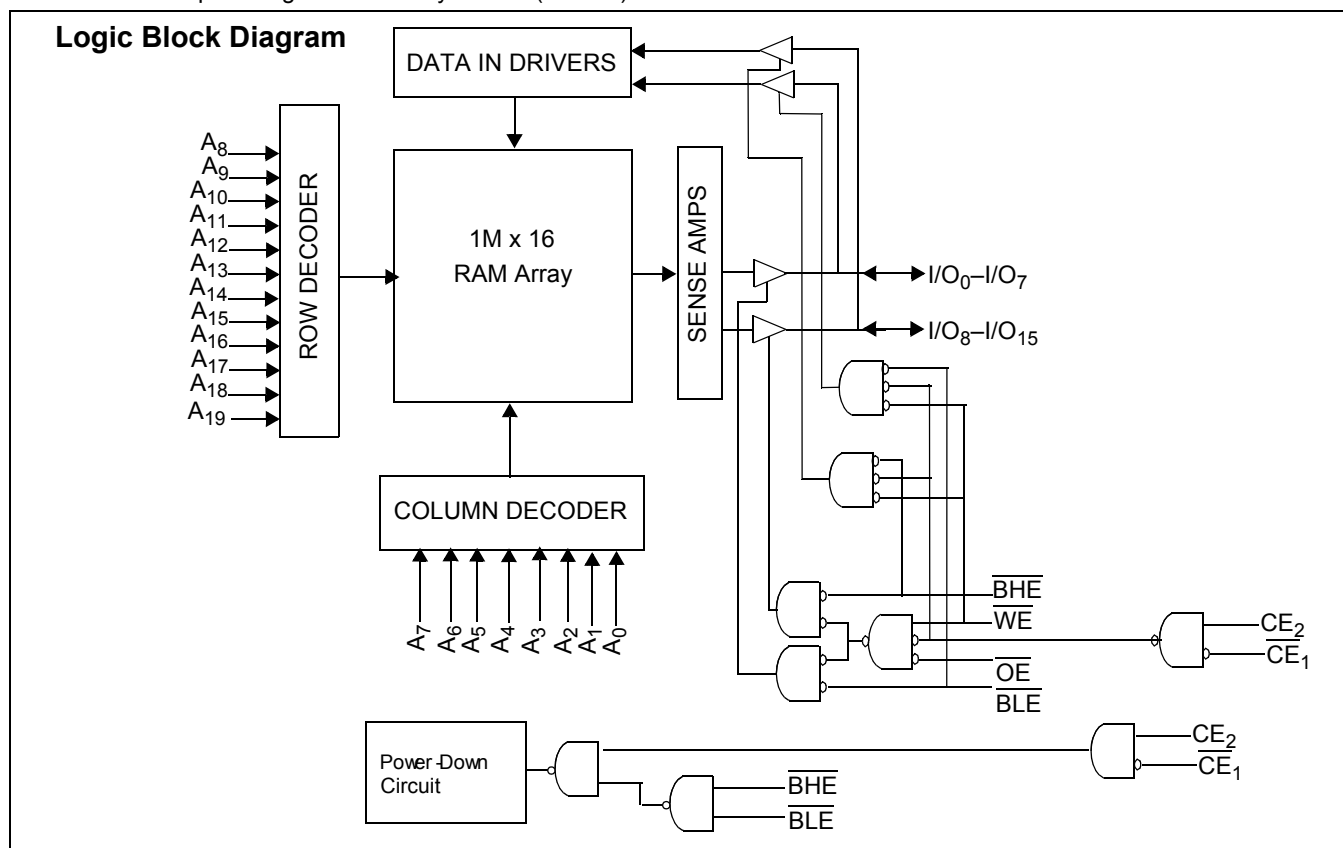
Functional Description^[1]

The CYU01M16SCCU is a high-performance CMOS Pseudo Static RAM organized as 1M words by 16 bits that supports an asynchronous memory interface. This device features advanced circuit design to provide ultra-low active current. This is ideal for providing More Battery Life™ (MoBL®) in

portable applications such as cellular telephones. The device can be put into standby mode when deselected ($\overline{\text{CE}}_1$ HIGH or $\overline{\text{CE}}_2$ LOW or both $\overline{\text{BHE}}$ and $\overline{\text{BLE}}$ are HIGH). The input/output pins (I/O_0 through I/O_{15}) are placed in a high-impedance state when: deselected ($\overline{\text{CE}}_1$ HIGH or $\overline{\text{CE}}_2$ LOW), outputs are disabled ($\overline{\text{OE}}$ HIGH), both $\overline{\text{Byte High Enable}}$ and $\overline{\text{Byte Low Enable}}$ are disabled ($\overline{\text{BHE}}$, $\overline{\text{BLE}}$ HIGH), or during a write operation ($\overline{\text{CE}}_1$ LOW and $\overline{\text{CE}}_2$ HIGH and $\overline{\text{WE}}$ LOW).

Writing to the device is accomplished by taking Chip Enable ($\overline{\text{CE}}_1$ LOW and $\overline{\text{CE}}_2$ HIGH) and Write Enable ($\overline{\text{WE}}$) input LOW. If $\overline{\text{Byte Low Enable}}$ ($\overline{\text{BLE}}$) is LOW, then data from I/O pins (I/O_0 through I/O_7), is written into the location specified on the address pins (A_0 through A_{19}). If $\overline{\text{Byte High Enable}}$ ($\overline{\text{BHE}}$) is LOW, then data from I/O pins (I/O_8 through I/O_{15}) is written into the location specified on the address pins (A_0 through A_{19}).

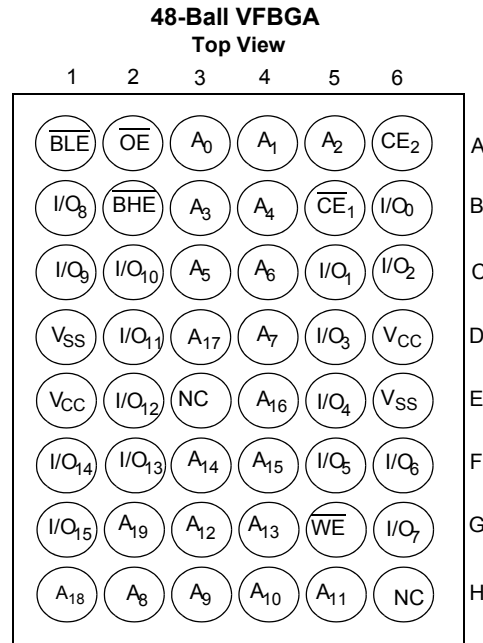
Reading from the device is accomplished by taking Chip Enables ($\overline{\text{CE}}_1$ LOW and $\overline{\text{CE}}_2$ HIGH) and Output Enable ($\overline{\text{OE}}$) LOW while forcing the Write Enable ($\overline{\text{WE}}$) HIGH. If $\overline{\text{Byte Low Enable}}$ ($\overline{\text{BLE}}$) is LOW, then data from the memory location specified by the address pins will appear on I/O_0 to I/O_7 . If $\overline{\text{Byte High Enable}}$ ($\overline{\text{BHE}}$) is LOW, then data from memory will appear on I/O_8 to I/O_{15} . Refer to the truth table for a complete description of read and write modes.

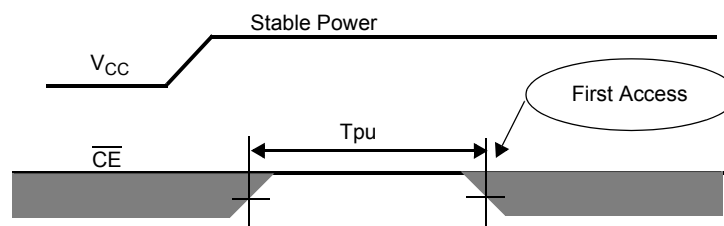

Power-up Characteristics

The initialization sequence is shown in the figure below. Chip Select should be CE₁ HIGH or CE₂ LOW for at least 200 μs after V_{CC} has reached a stable value. No access must be attempted during this period of 200 μs.

Page Mode

This device can be operated in a page read mode. This is accomplished by initiating a normal read of the device.

In order to operate the device in page mode, the upper order address bits should be fixed for four-word page access operation, all address bits except for A1 and A0 should be fixed until the page access is completed. For an eight-word page access, all address bits, except for A2, A1, and A0,

should be fixed. For a sixteen-word page mode all address bits, except for A3, A2, A1, and A0, should be fixed.

The supported page lengths are four, eight, and sixteen words. Random page read is supported for all three four, eight, and sixteen-word page read options. Therefore, any address can be used as the starting address.

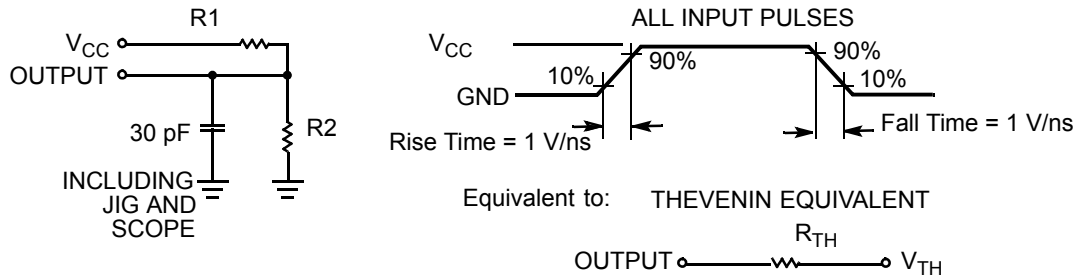

- In order to achieve 70-ns performance, the read access must be Chip Enable ($\overline{CE}_1$ or CE₂) controlled. That is, the addresses must be stable prior to Chip Enable going active.

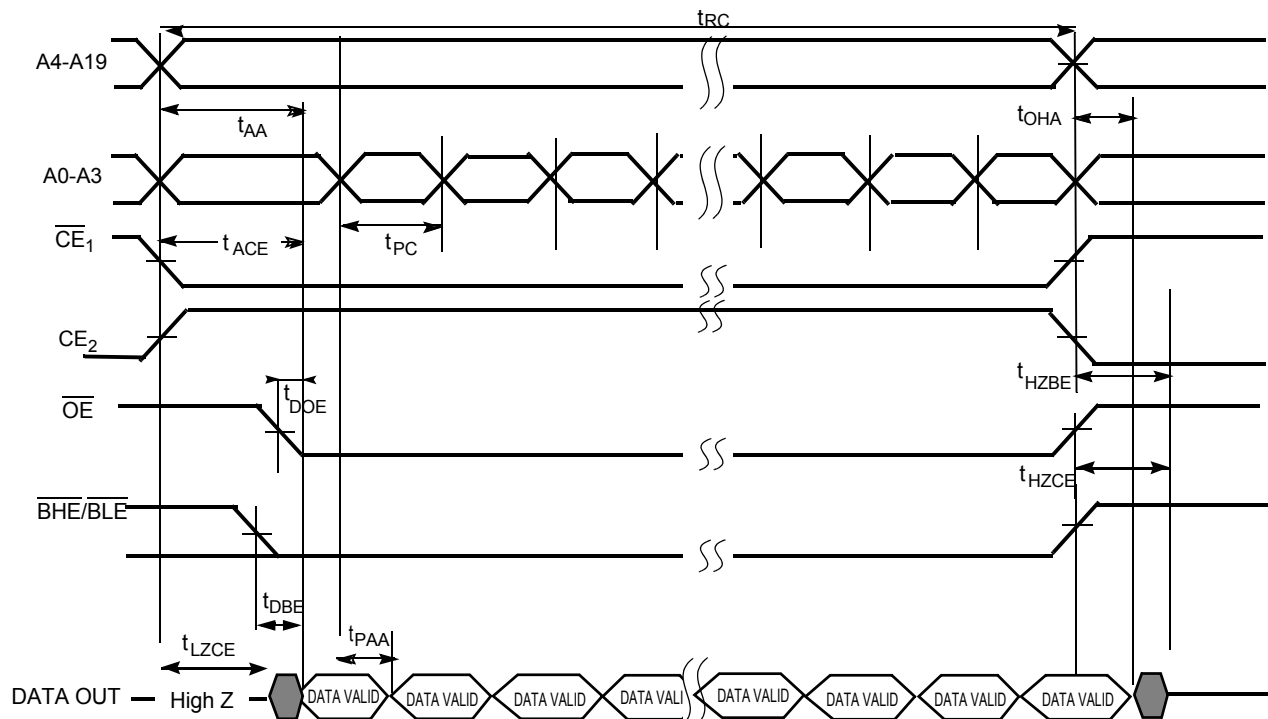

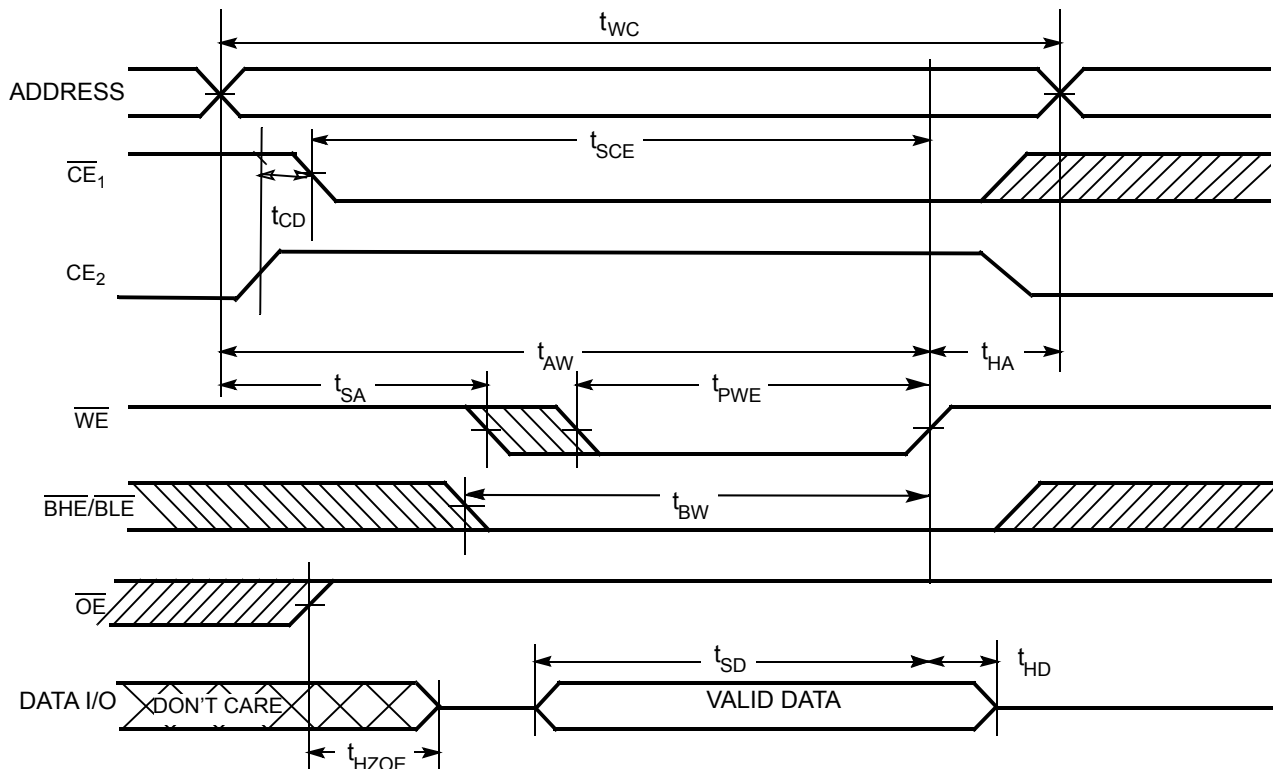

Write Cycle 1 ($\overline{WE}$ Controlled)^[15, 12, 16, 19, 20, 21]



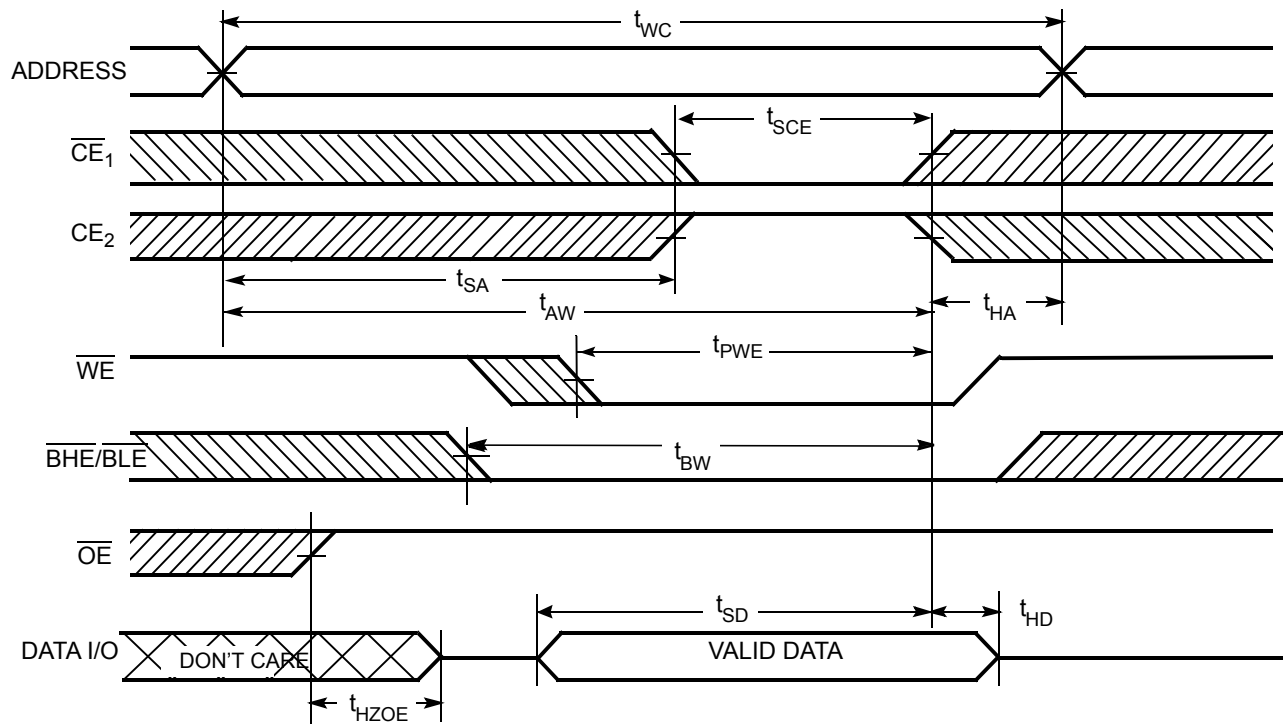

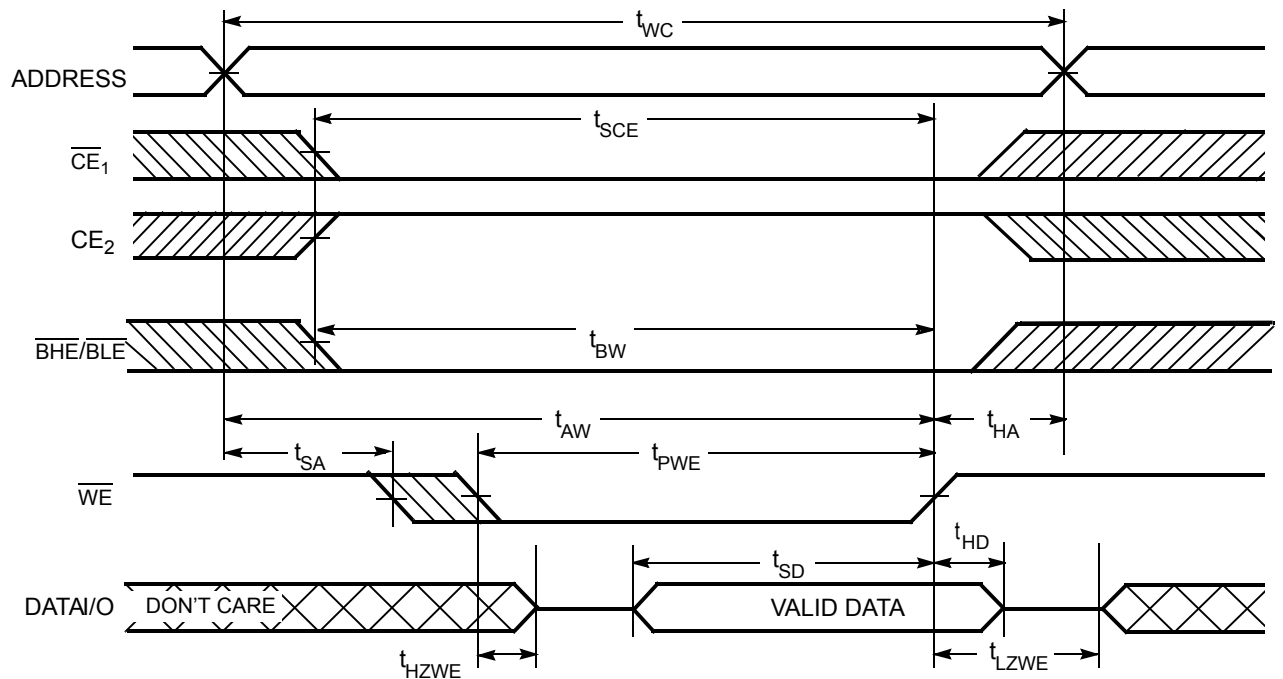

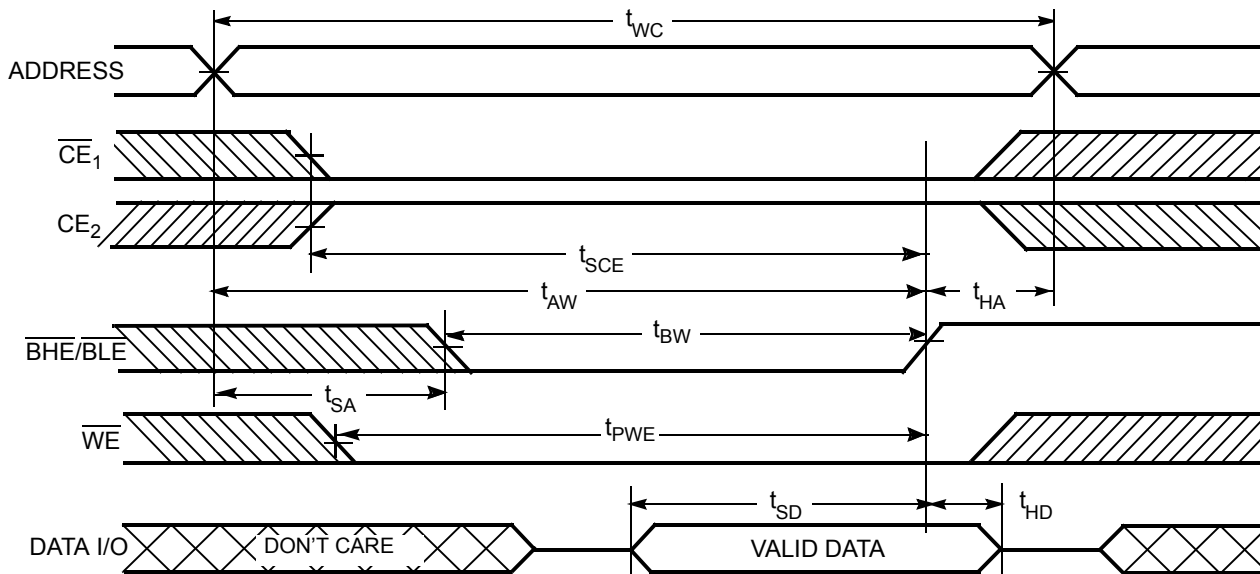


Write Cycle 3 ($\overline{WE}$ Controlled, $\overline{OE}$ LOW)^[16, 21]
