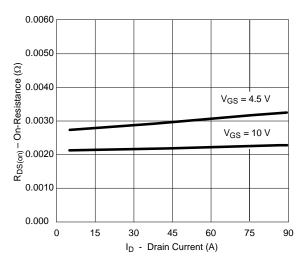


**Transconductance** 

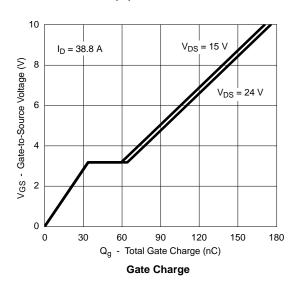




**Transfer Characteristics** 



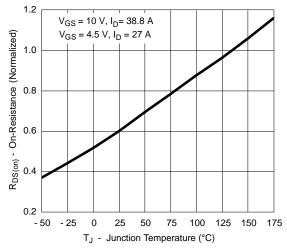
R<sub>DS(on)</sub> vs. Drain Current

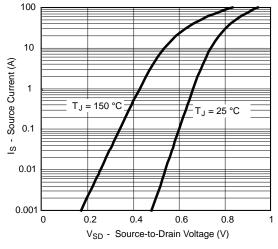
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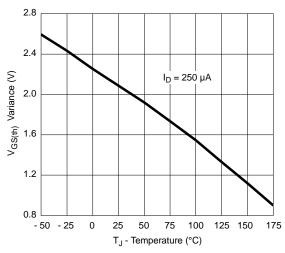
On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature



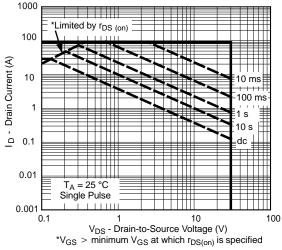
 $R_{DS(on)}$  vs.  $V_{GS}$  vs. Temperature



Forward Diode Voltage vs. Temperature



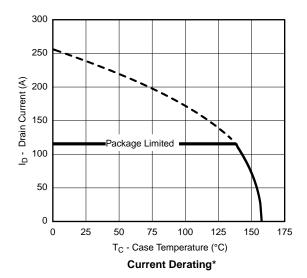
Threshold Voltage

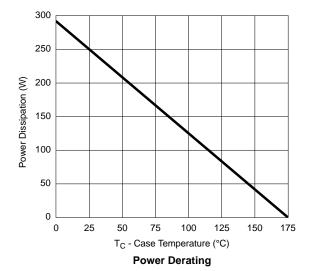


Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient

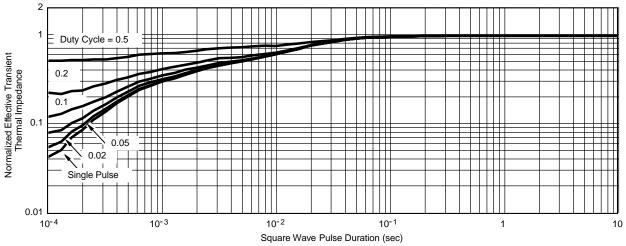

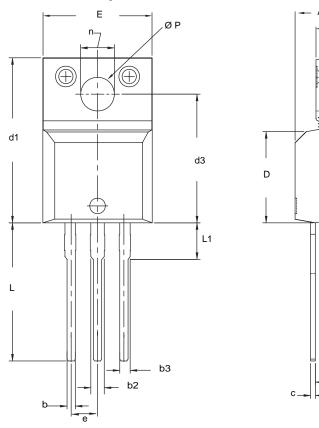


Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case
