
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


Gate Source Voltage vs. Gate Current













Gate Source Voltage vs. Gate Current












On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage







Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage











Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient


