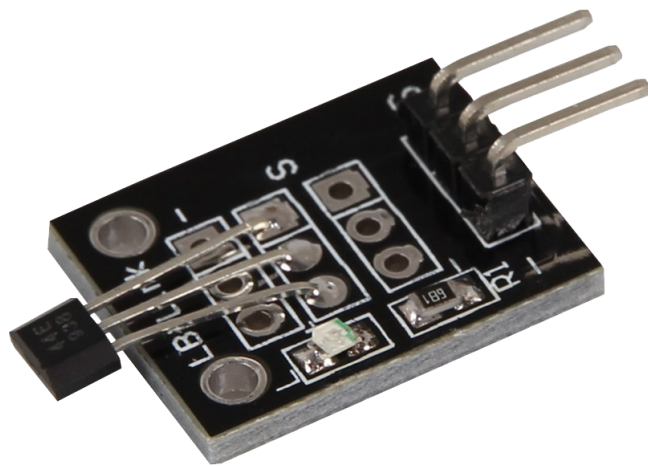

Chipset	A3141
Sensor Type	Hall Effect Transistor/Switch

The transistor switches through if the module is held in a magnetic field. This can then be read out at the signal output as an analog voltage value.

## 2. PIN-ASSIGNMENT



Pin Assignment Arduino	
LED +	Pin 13
LED -	Pin GND
Signal	Pin 10
+V	Pin 5V
GND	Pin GND

Pin Assignment Raspberry Pi	
Signal	GPIO24 [Pin 18]
+V	3,3V [Pin 1]
GND	Masse [Pin 6]

### 3. CODE EXAMPLE ARDUINO

---

This is an example program that lights up an LED when a signal is detected on the sensor. The KY-011, KY-016 or KY-029 modules can also be used as LEDs, for example.

int Led = 13 ;// Declaration of the LED output pin
int Sensor = 10; // Declaration of the sensor input pin
int val; // Temporary Variable

void setup ()
{
  pinMode (Led, OUTPUT) ; // Initialization of output pin
  pinMode (Sensor, INPUT) ; // Sensor pin initialization
  digitalWrite(Sensor, HIGH); // Activation of internal pull-up resistor
}

void loop ()
{
  val = digitalRead (Sensor) ; // The current signal at the sensor is read out

  if (val == HIGH) // If a signal could be detected, the LED is switched on.
  {
    digitalWrite (Led, LOW);
  }
  else
  {
    digitalWrite (Led, HIGH);
  }
}
```

---

import RPi.GPIO as GPIO
import time

GPIO.setmode(GPIO.BCM)

# The input pin to which the sensor is connected is declared here. In addition,
# the PullUP resistor at the input is also activated
GPIO_PIN = 24
GPIO.setup(GPIO_PIN, GPIO.IN, pull_up_down = GPIO.PUD_UP)

print "Sensor-Test [druecken Sie STRG+C, um den Test zu beenden]"

# This output function is executed on signal detection
def ausgabeFunktion(null):
    print("Signal erkannt")

# When a signal is detected (falling signal edge), the output function is
# triggered
GPIO.add_event_detect(GPIO_PIN, GPIO.FALLING, callback=ausgabeFunktion,
bouncetime=100)

# main loop
try:

        time.sleep(1)

### Symbol on electrical and electronic equipment
