The LA7161NV is VHF band RF modules that support channels 3 and 4 in the US, channels 1 and 2 in Japan, and channel 13 in Taiwan.

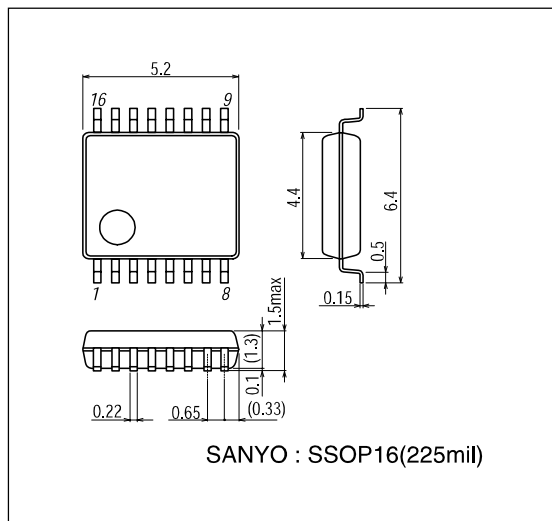

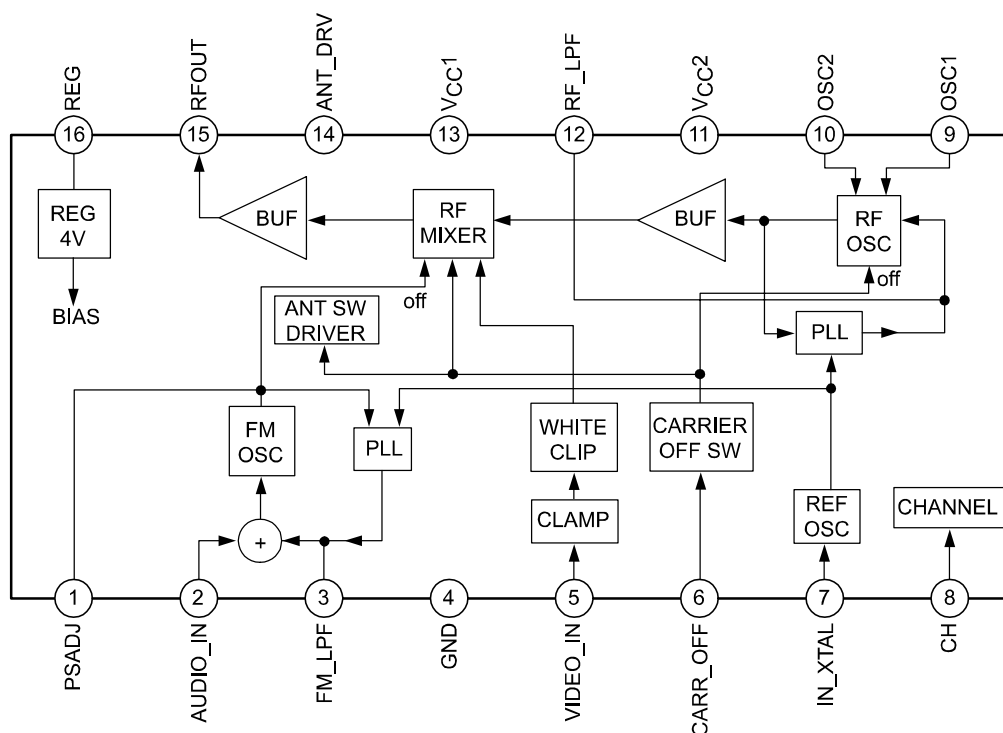
