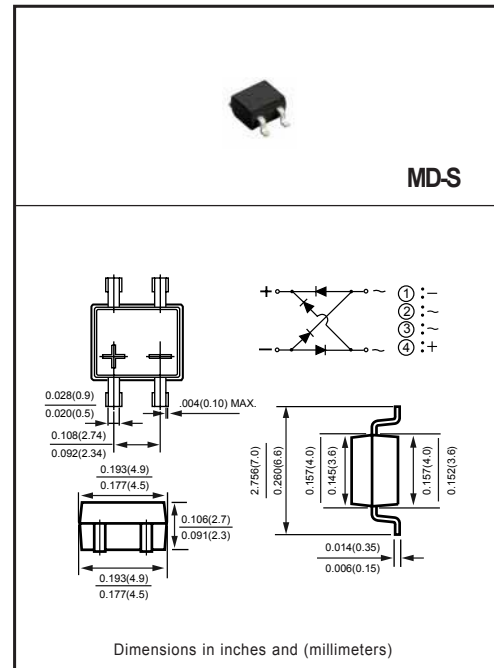

RATING AND CHARACTERISTICS CURVES (MB1S THRU MB10S)

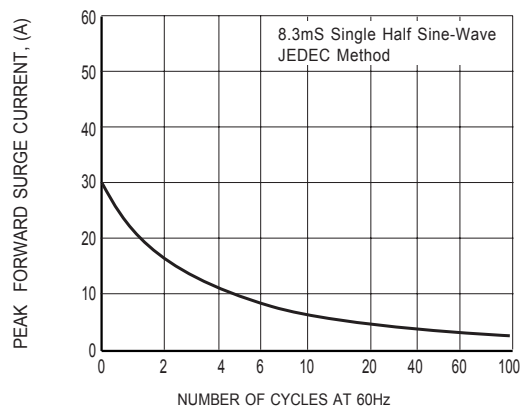


FIG. 1 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE
FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

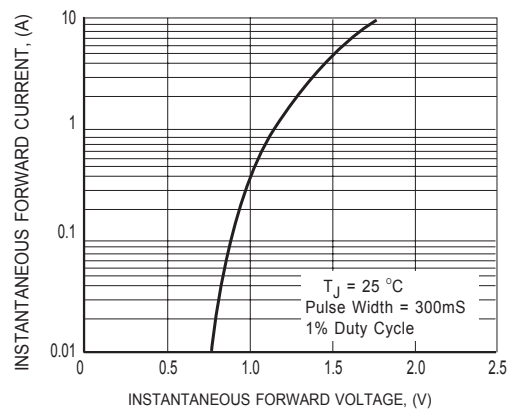


FIG. 2 TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS
FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

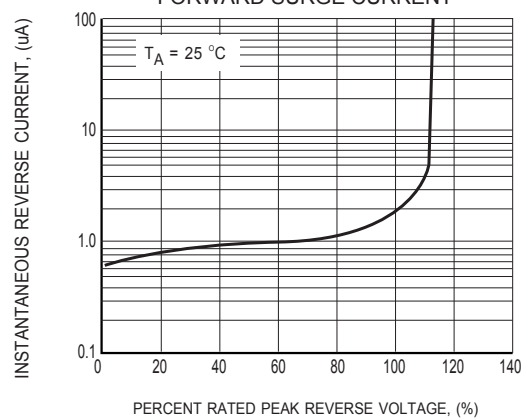


FIG. 3 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

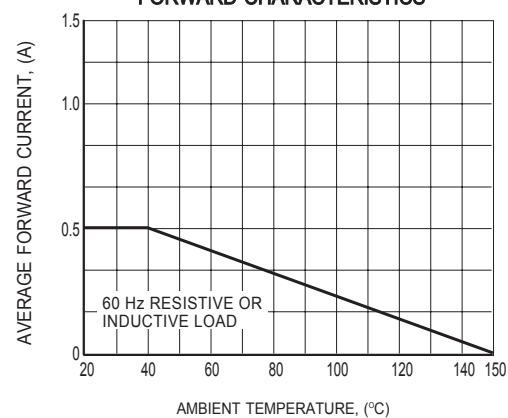
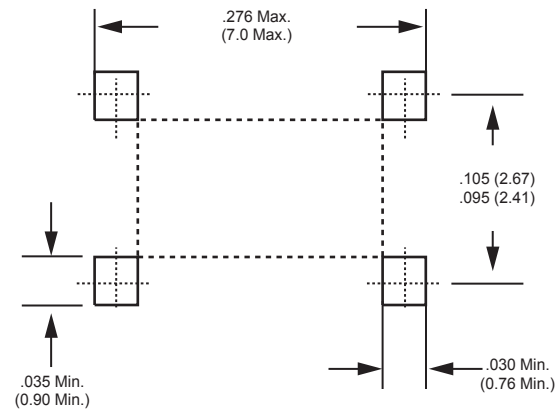


FIG. 4 TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT
