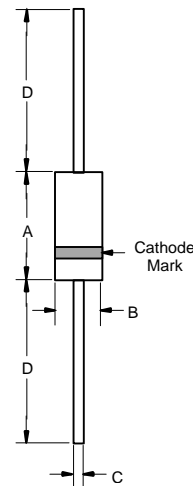

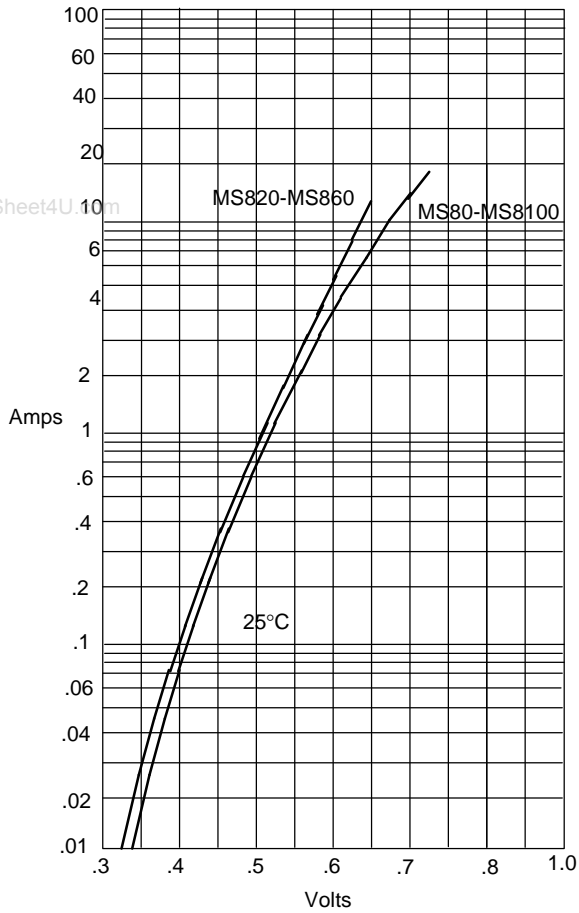

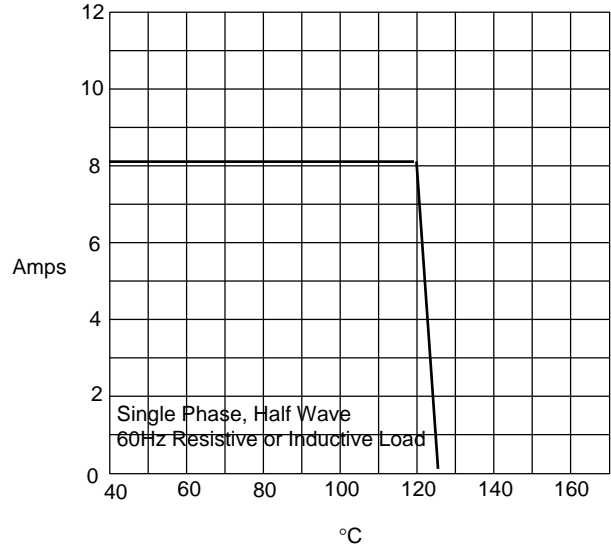

Typical Forward Characteristics



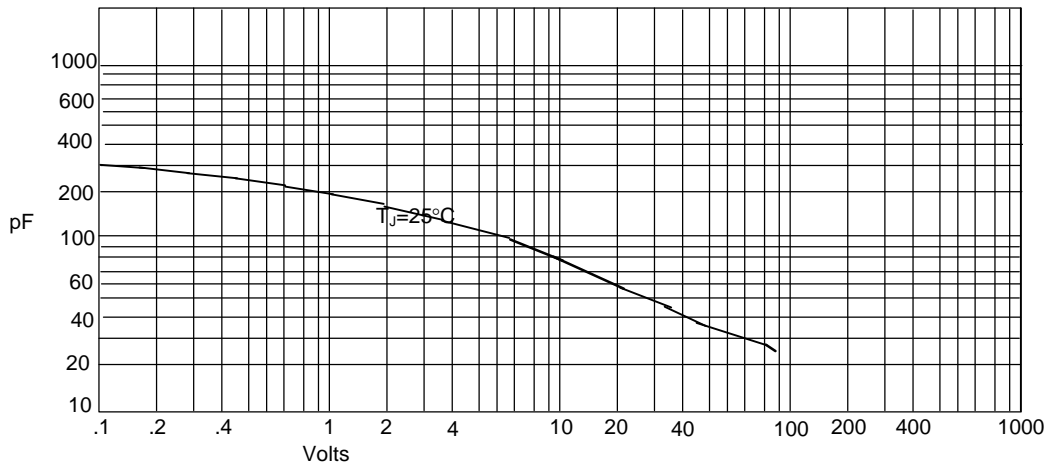
Instantaneous Forward Current - Amperes versus

Ambient Temperature - °C

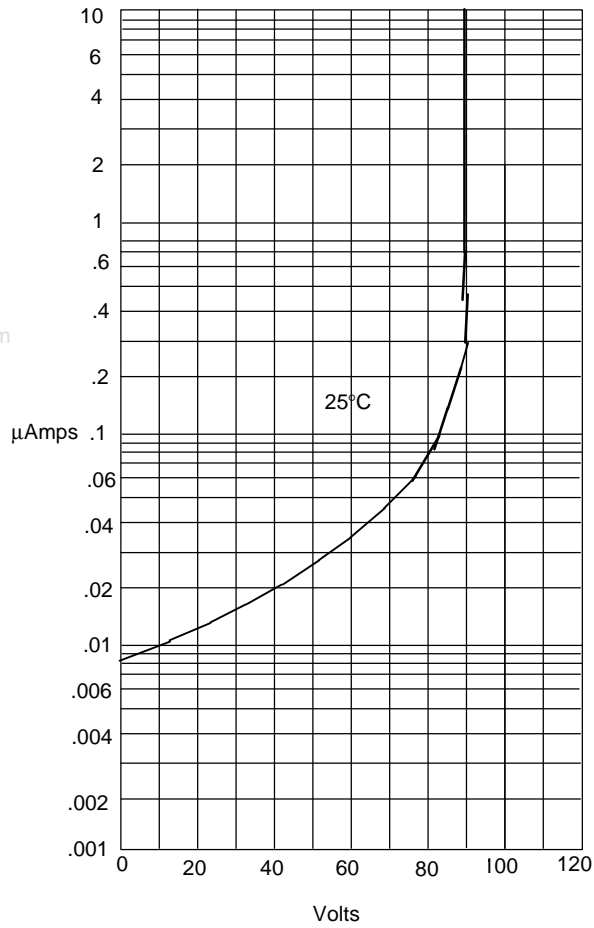

Reverse Voltage - Volts

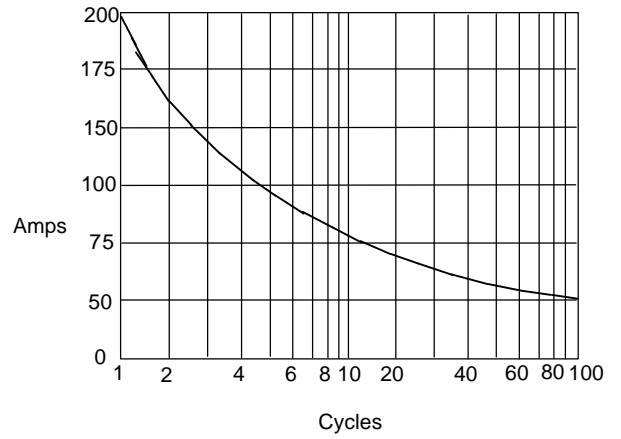
