

Minmax's MSKW3000–Series are in "gull–wing" SMT package. The series consists of 14 models with input voltage ranges of 9–36VDC and 18–75VDC which provide precisely regulated output voltages of 3.3V, 5V, 12V, 15V, ±5V, ±12V and ±15VDC.

The -40°C to +71°C operating temperature range makes it ideal for data communication equipments, mobile battery driven equipments, distributed power systems, telecommunication equipments, mixed analog/digital subsystems, process/machine control equipments, computer peripheral systems and industrial robot systems.

The modules have a maximum power rating of 5W and a typical full-load efficiency of 83%, continuous short circuit, Remote on/off EN55022 Class A conducted noise compliance minimize design-in time, cost and eliminate the need for external filtering.









## Single Output

Dual Output




## Input Voltage Transient Rating







Efficiency vs Input Voltage (Single Output)




Efficiency vs Output Load (Single Output)

Efficiency vs Output Load (Dual Output)




### Test Configurations

#### Input Reflected-Ripple Current Test Setup

Input reflected-ripple current is measured with a inductor Lin (4.7uH) and Cin (220uF, ESR < 1.0Ω at 100 KHz) to simulate source impedance.


Capacitor Cin, offsets possible battery impedance. Current ripple is measured at the input terminals of the module, measurement bandwidth is 0-500 KHz.




### Peak-to-Peak Output Noise Measurement Test

Use a Cout 0.47uF ceramic capacitor.

Scope measurement should be made by using a BNC socket, measurement bandwidth is 0-20 MHz. Position the load between 50 mm and 75 mm from the DC/DC Converter.





**Design & Feature Considerations** 

### Input Source I Remote On/Off

Positive logic remote on/off turns the module on during a logic high voltage on the remote on/off pin, and off during a logic low.

To turn the power module on and off, the user must supply a switch to control the voltage between the on/off terminal and the -Vin terminal.

The switch can be an open collector or equivalent.

A logic low is -0.7V to 0.8V.

A logic high is 2.5V to 5.5V.

The maximum sink current of the switch at on/off terminal during a logic low is 300 uA.

The maximum sink current of the switch at on/off terminal = 2.5 to 5.5V is 200uA or open.

### Maximum Capacitive Load

The MSKW2000 series has limitation of maximum connected capacitance at the output.

The power module may be operated in current limiting mode during start-up, affecting the ramp-up and the startup time

For optimum performance we recommend 100uF maximum capacitive load for dual outputs and 680uF capacitive load for single outputs.

The maximum capacitance can be found in the data sheet.

### **Overcurrent Protection**


To provide protection in a fault (output overload) condition, the unit is equipped with internal current limiting circuitry and can endure current limiting for an unlimited duration. At the point of current-limit inception, the unit shifts from voltage control to current control. The unit operates normally once the output current is brought back into its specified range.

### Input Source Impedance

The power module should be connected to a low ac-impedance input source. Highly inductive source impedances can affect the stability of the power module.

In applications where power is supplied over long lines and output loading is high, it may be necessary to use a capacitor at the input to ensure startup.


Capacitor mounted close to the power module helps ensure stability of the unit, it is recommended to use a good quality low Equivalent Series Resistance (ESR <  $1.0\Omega$  at 100 KHz) capacitor of a 3.3uF for the 12V input devices and a 2.2uF for the 24V and 48V devices.




**Output Ripple Reduction** 

A good quality low ESR capacitor placed as close as practicable across the load will give the best ripple and noise performance.

To reduce output ripple, it is recommended to use 3.3uF capacitors at the output.






### Thermal Considerations

Many conditions affect the thermal performance of the power module, such as orientation, airflow over the module and board spacing. To avoid exceeding the maximum temperature rating of the components inside the power module, the case temperature must be kept below 90°C.


The derating curves are determined from measurements obtained in an experimental apparatus.






