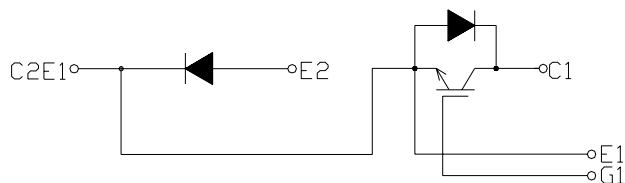


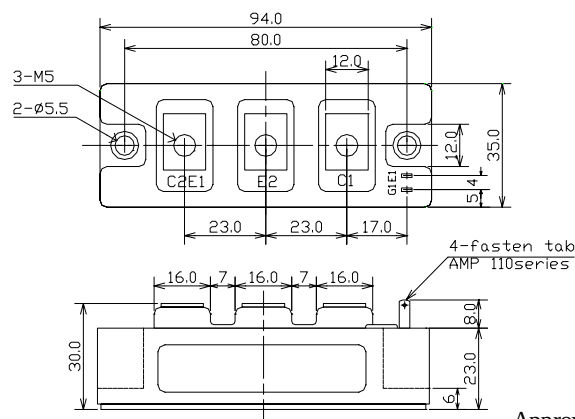

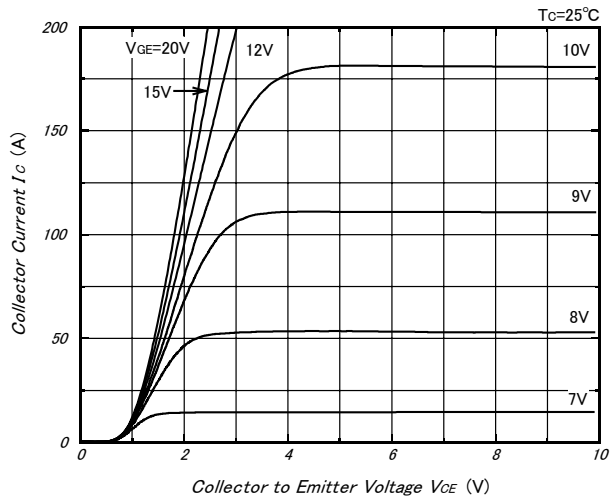


Fig.2- Collector to Emitter On Voltage vs. Gate to Emitter Voltage (Typical)

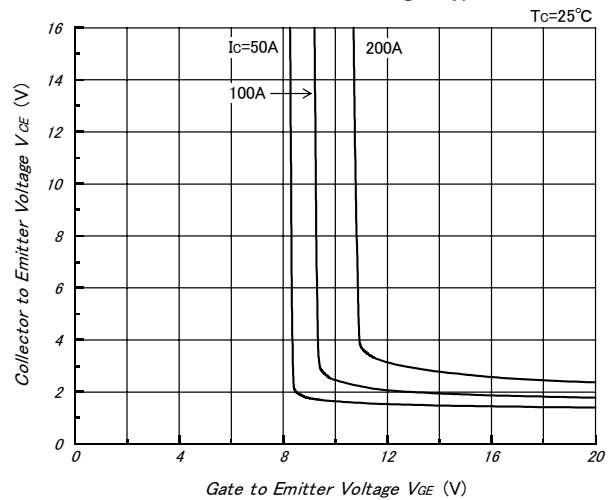


Fig.3- Collector to Emitter On Voltage vs. Gate to Emitter Voltage (Typical)

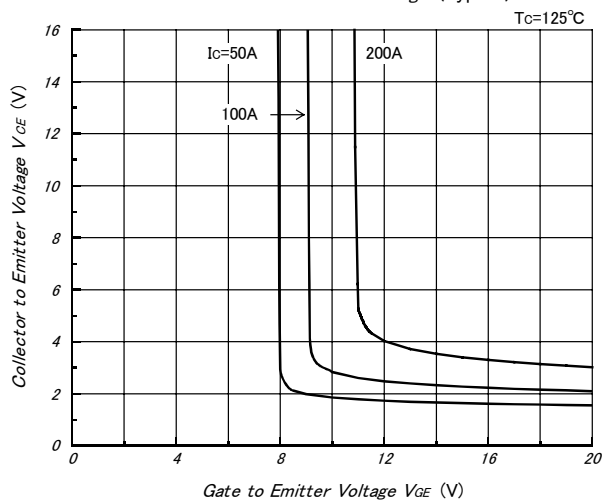


Fig.4- Gate Charge vs. Collector to Emitter Voltage (Typical)

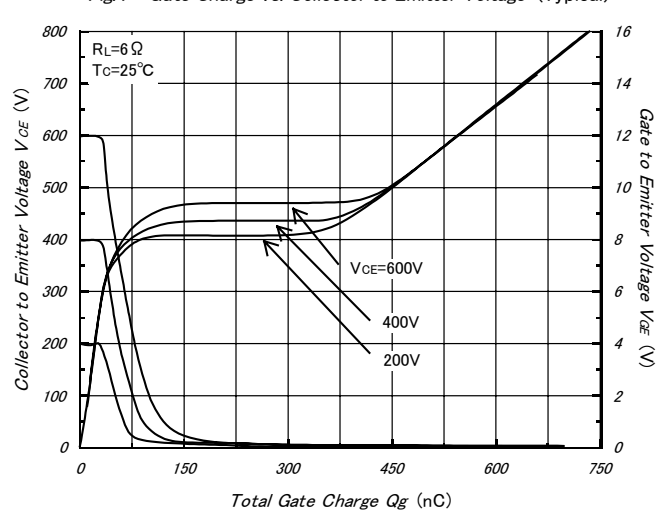


Fig.5- Capacitance vs. Collector to Emitter Voltage (Typical)

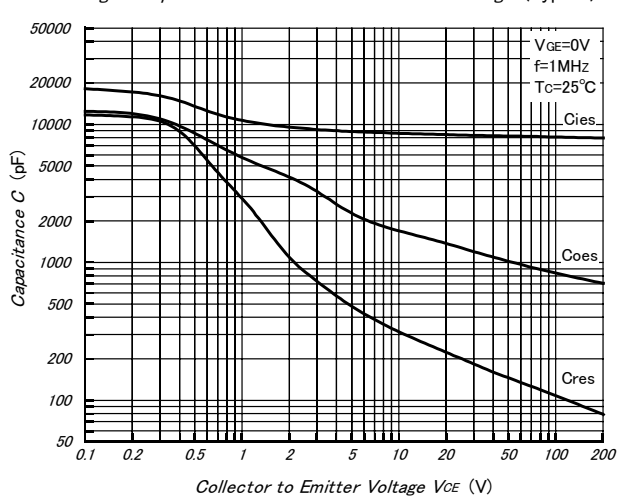


Fig.6- Collector Current vs. Switching Time (Typical)

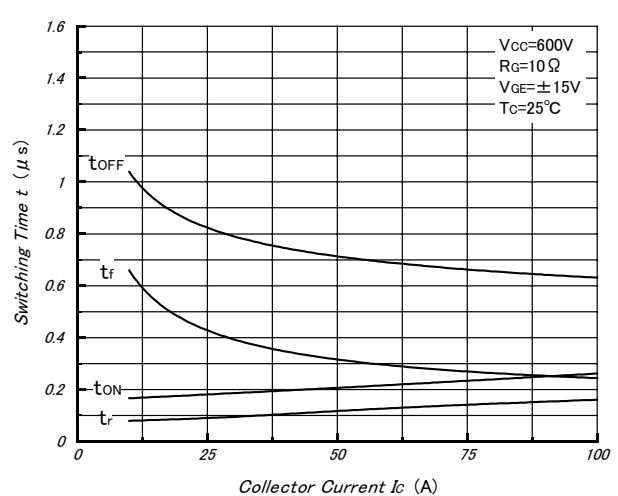


Fig.7- Series Gate Impedance vs. Switching Time (Typical)

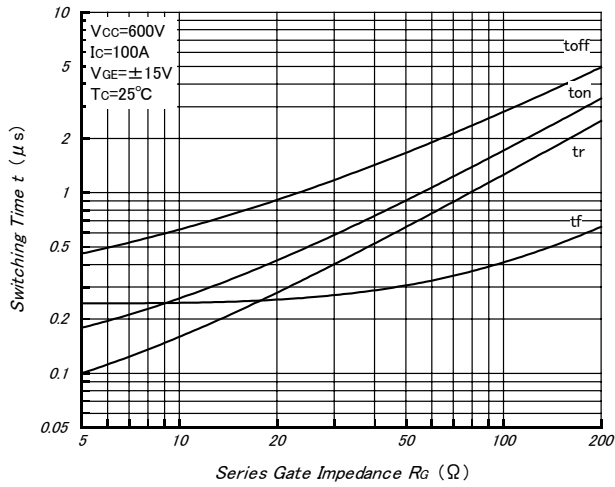


Fig.8- Forward Characteristics of Free Wheeling Diode (Typical)

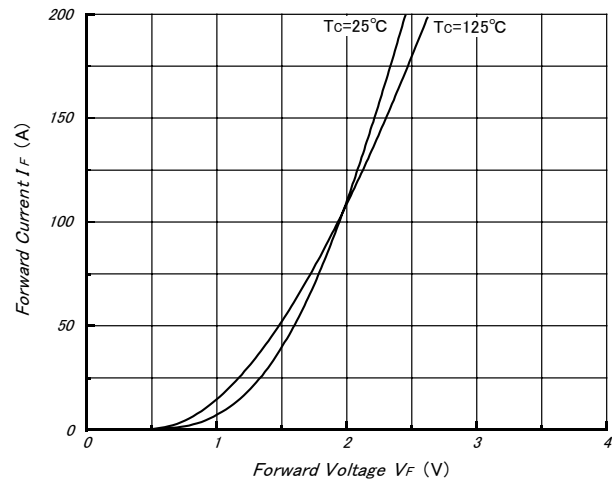


Fig.9- Reverse Recovery Characteristics (Typical)

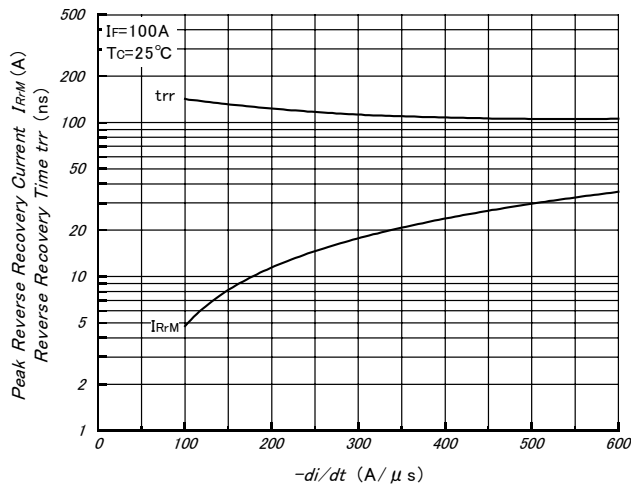


Fig.10- Reverse Bias Safe Operating Area

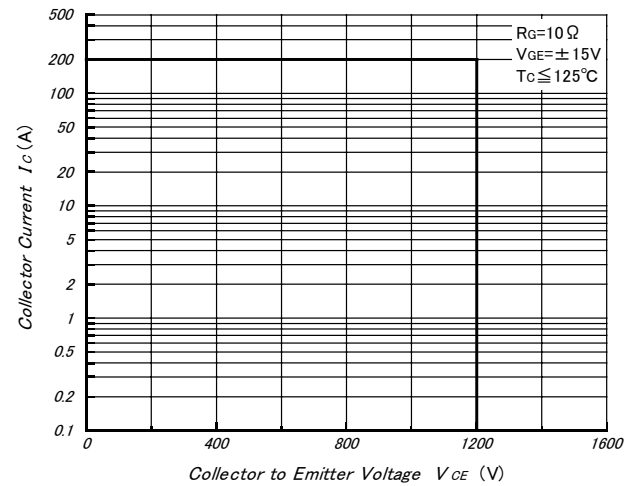


Fig.11- Transient Thermal Impedance
