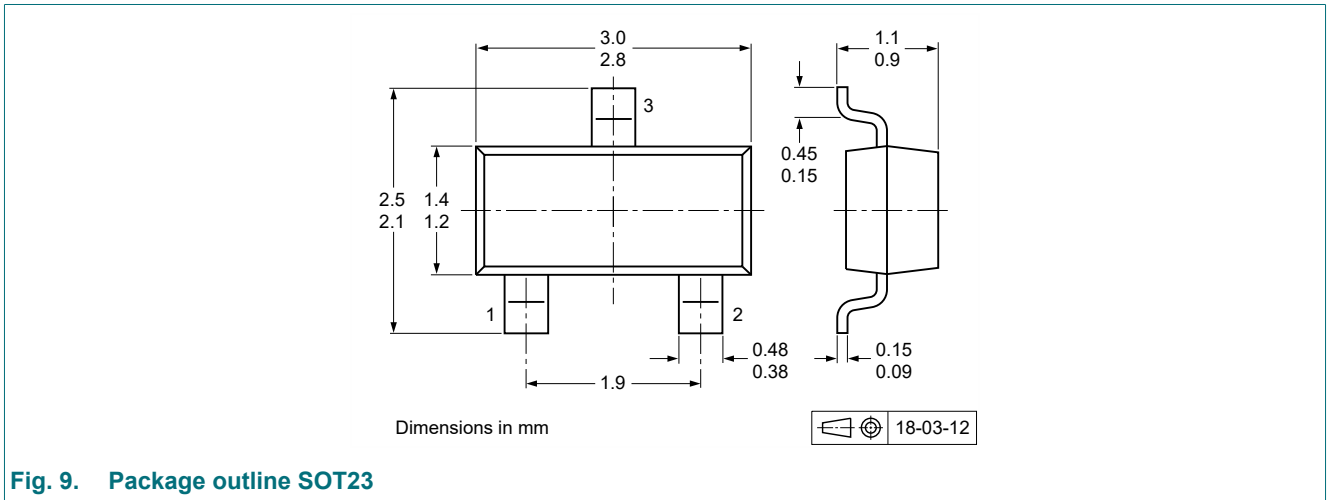


Fig. 9. Package outline SOT23

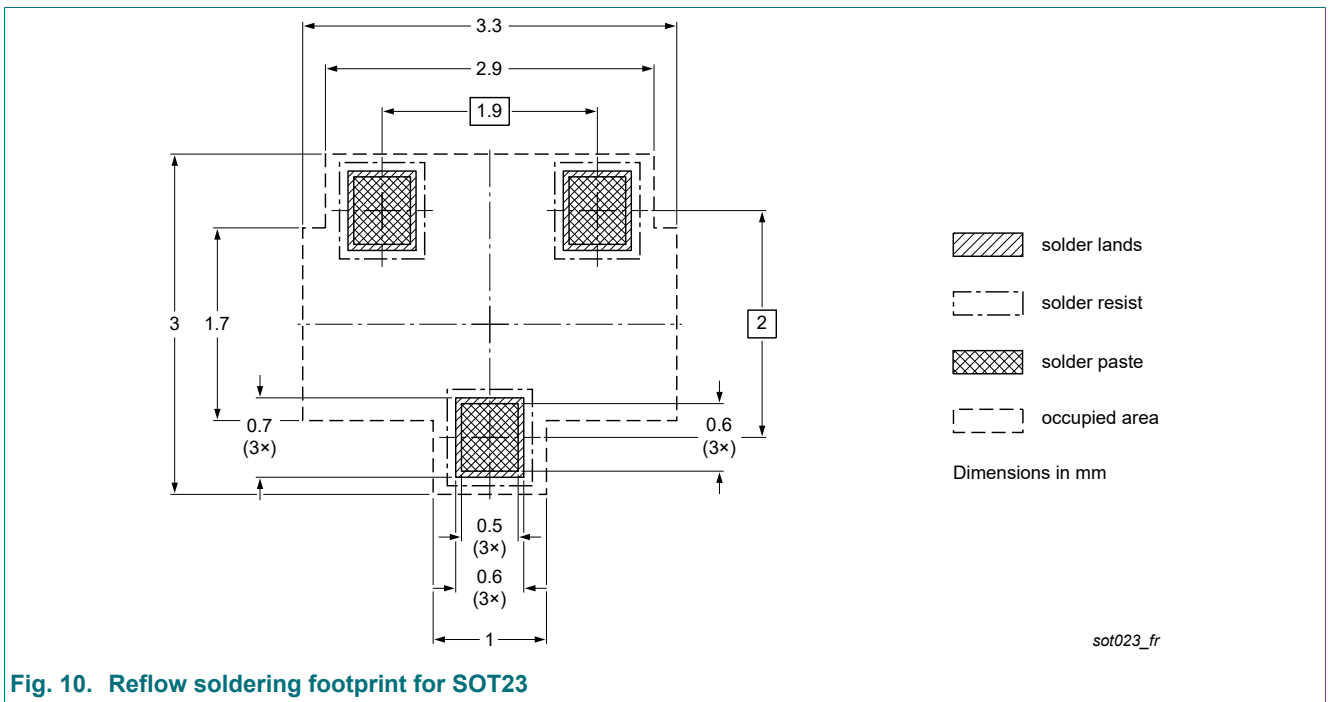


Fig. 10. Reflow soldering footprint for SOT23

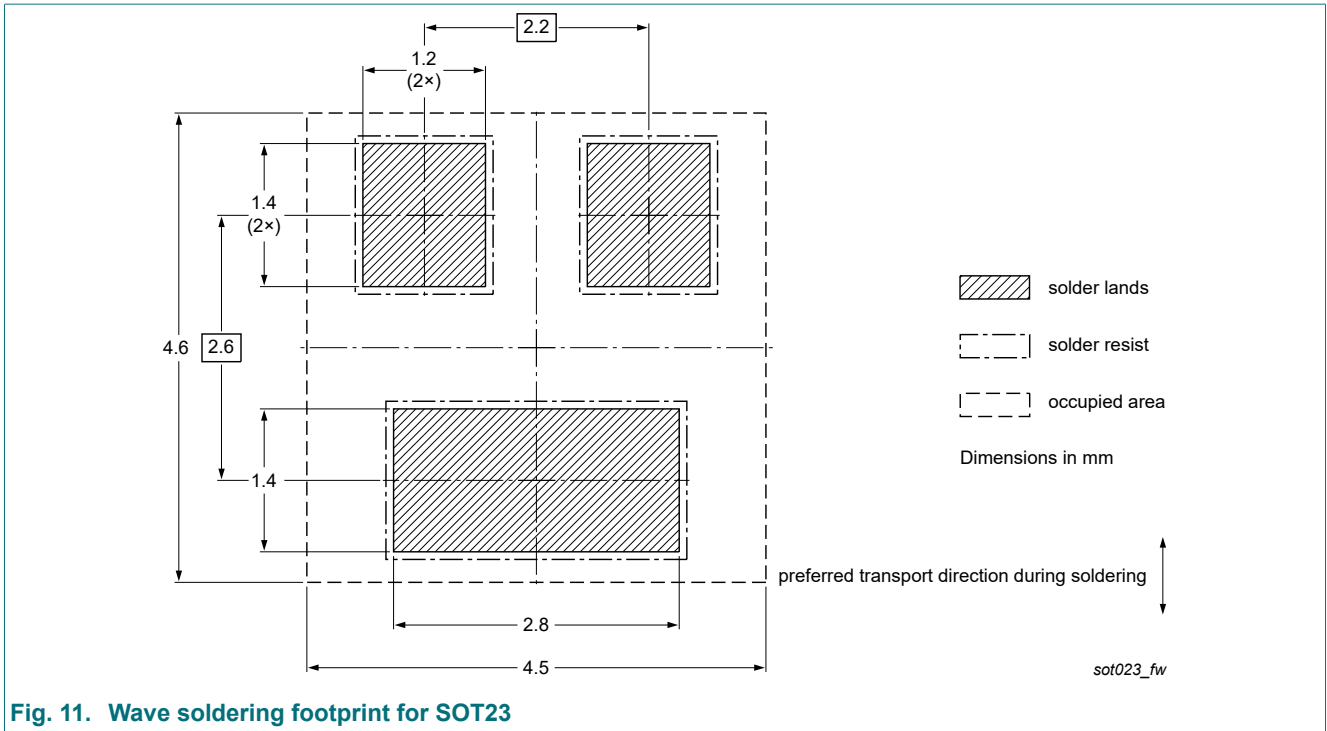


Fig. 11. Wave soldering footprint for SOT23
