




Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature

(1) $T_{j (init)} = 25^{\circ}C$; (2) $T_{j (init)} = 100^{\circ}C$


Single pulse avalanche rating; avalanche current as a function of avalanche time Fig 3.




Fig 6. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




Fig 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values




Fig 8. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

 $T_j = 25^{\circ}C; \ V_{DS} = 5V$




Fig 9. Transfer characteristics; drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values




Fig 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature




Fig 12. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 13. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature




Fig 14. Gate charge waveform definitions




Fig 15. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

 $T_j = 25^{\circ}C; \ I_D = 25A$




Fig 16. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




Fig 17. Source current as a function of source-drain voltage; typical values




Fig 18. Reverse recovery timing definition




Fig 19. Package outline SOT669 (LFPAK; Power-SO8)
