Fig.1-Forward Current Derating Curve

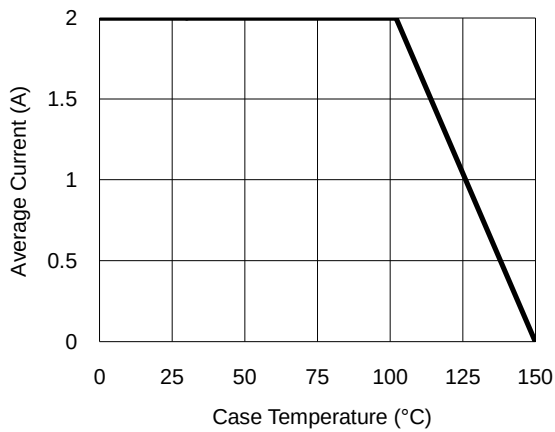


Fig.2- Surge Current Derating Curve

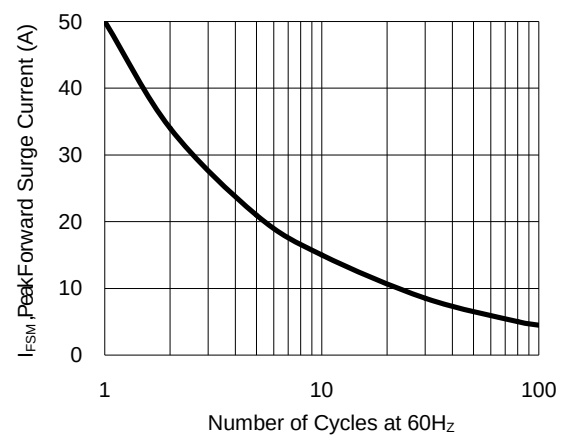


Fig.3- Typical Forward Voltage Characteristic

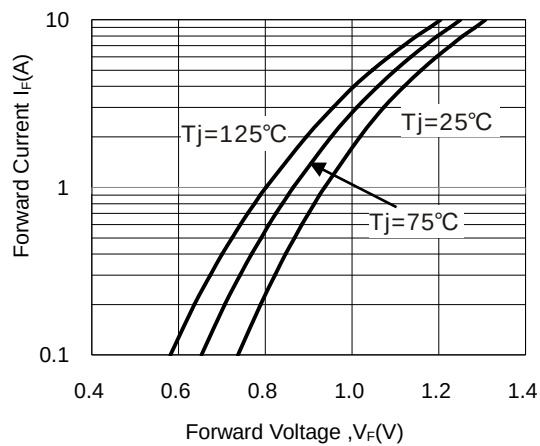
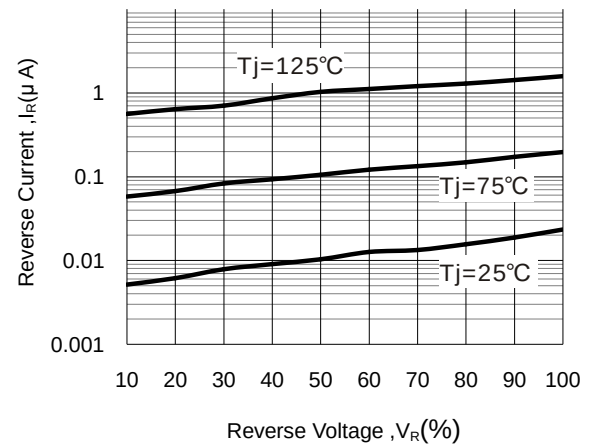


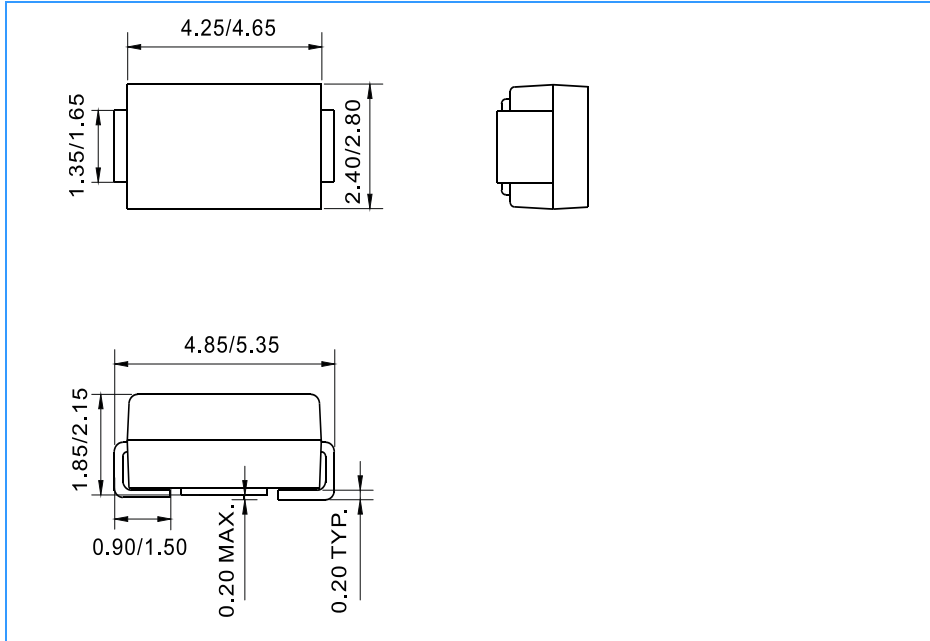
Fig.4- Typical Reverse Characteristic



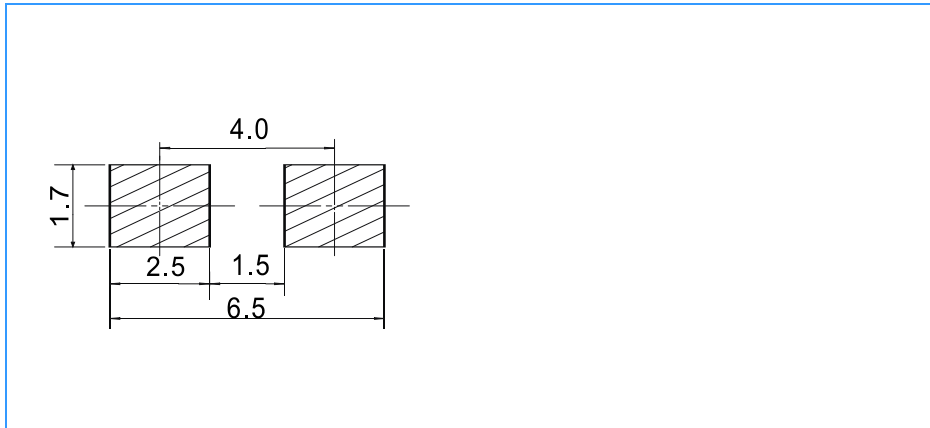
