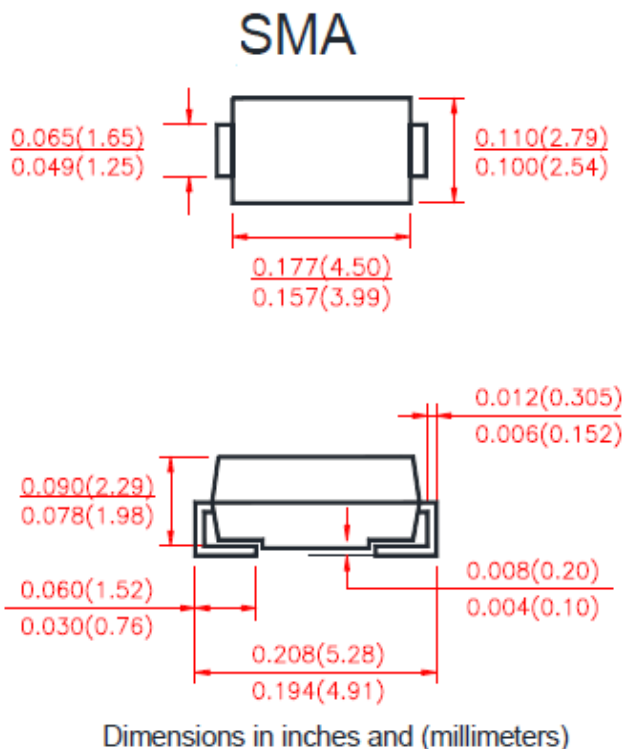

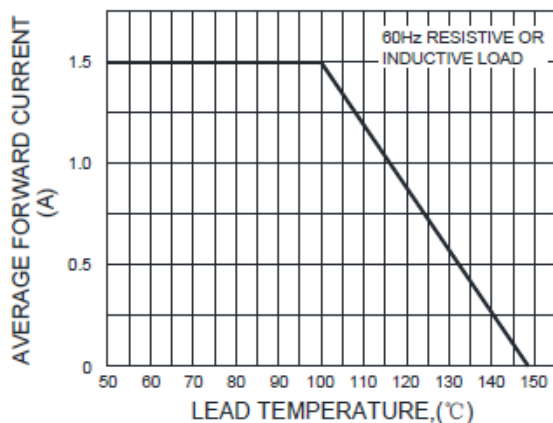

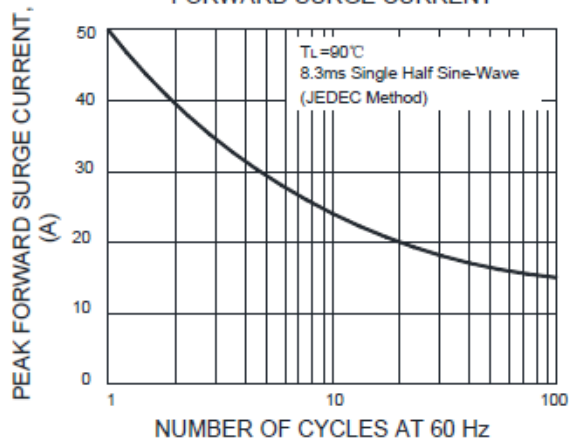

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FIG.3-TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

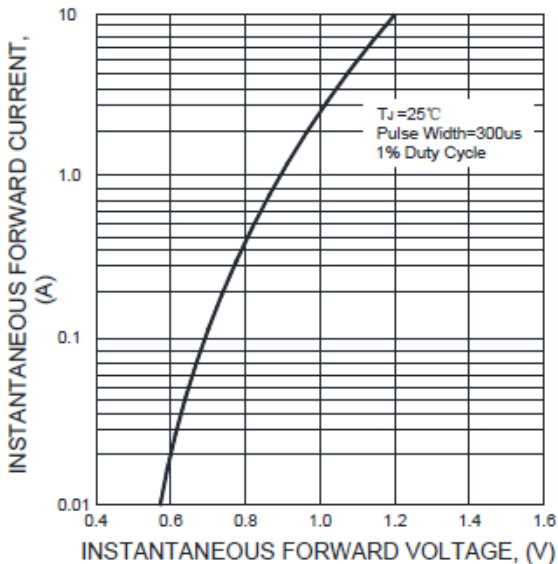


FIG.4-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

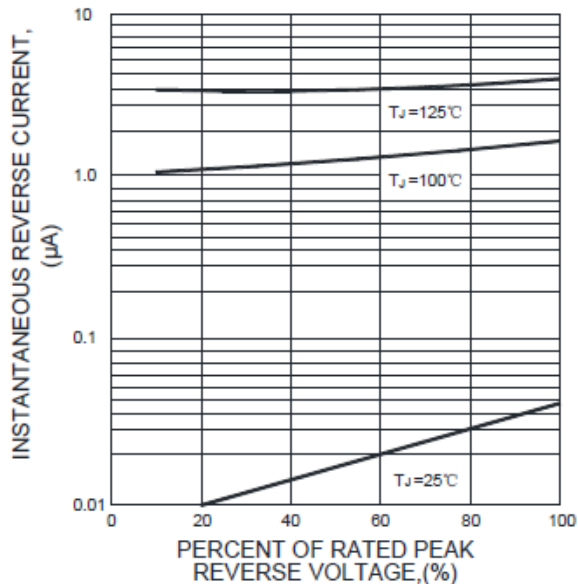
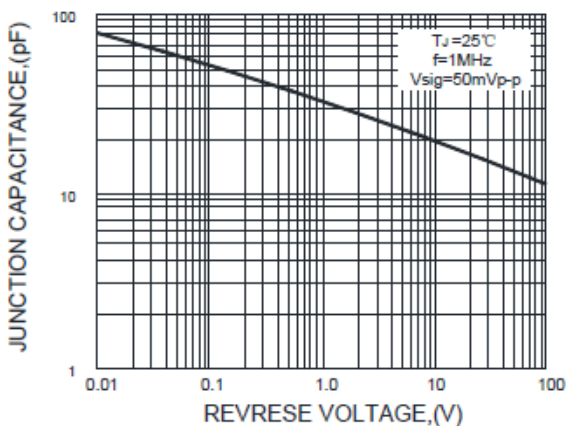


FIG.5-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE



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
