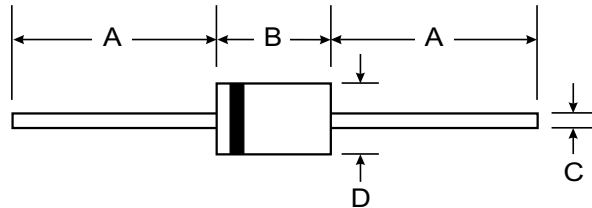

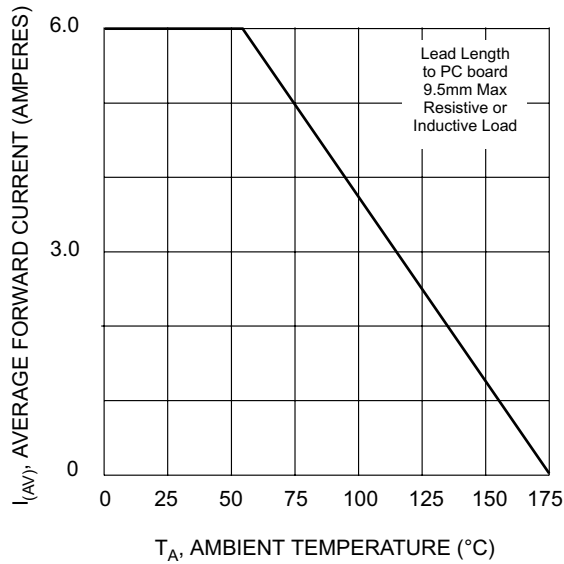


Fig. 1, Typical Fwd Current Derating Curve

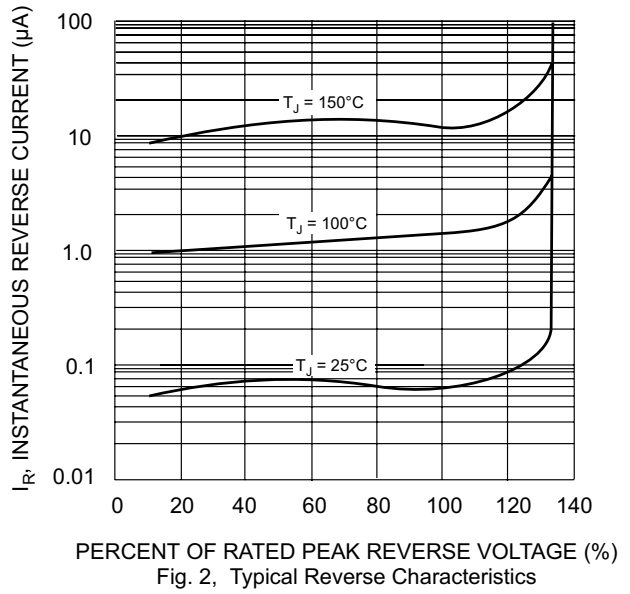


Fig. 2, Typical Reverse Characteristics

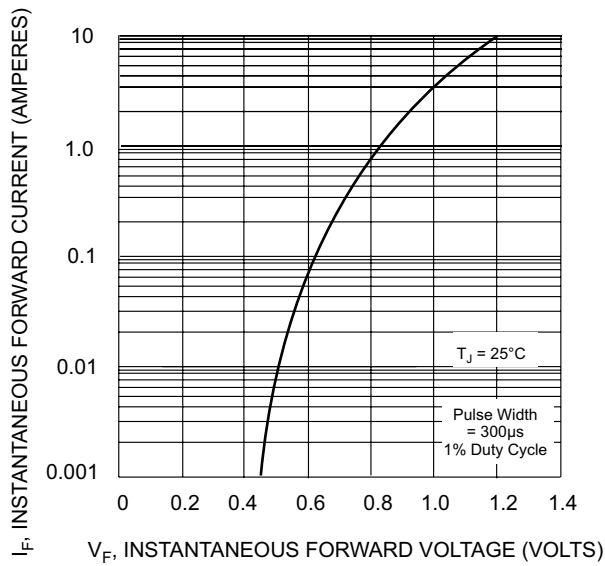


Fig. 3, Typical Instantaneous Fwd Characteristics

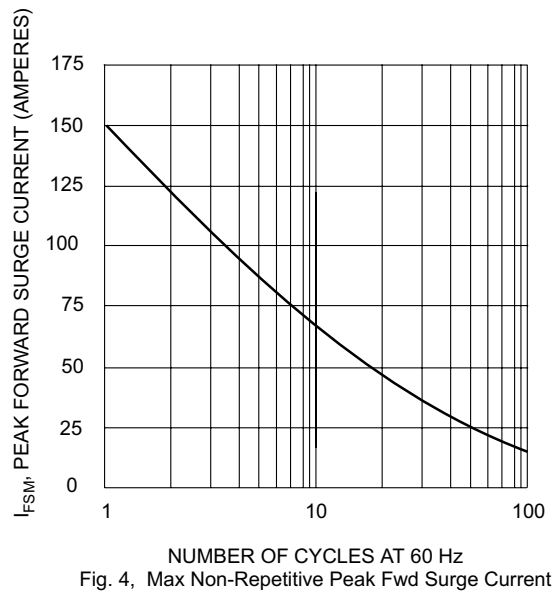


Fig. 4, Max Non-Repetitive Peak Fwd Surge Current

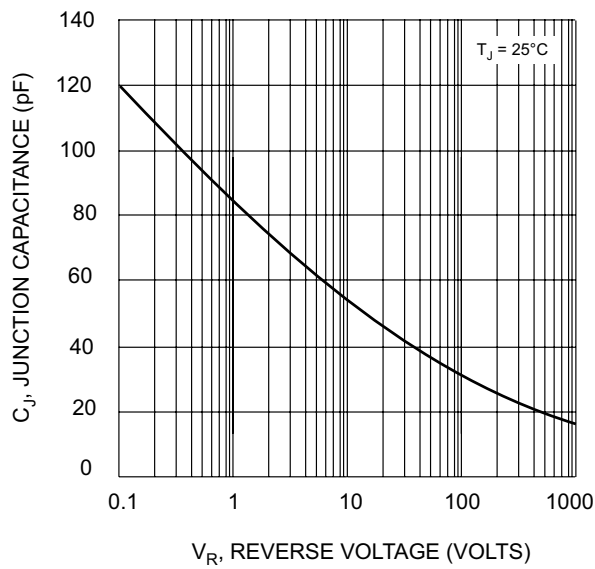


Fig. 5, Typical Junction Capacitance
