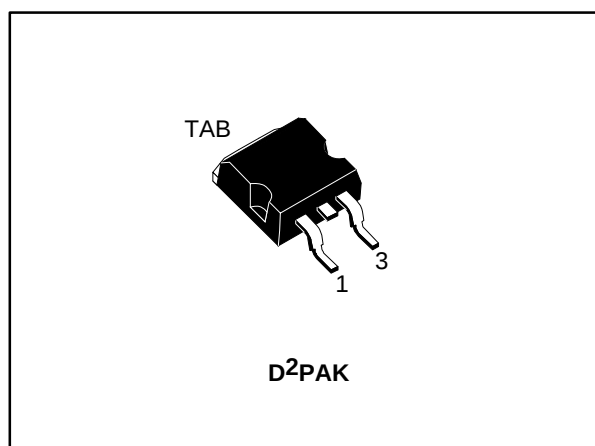
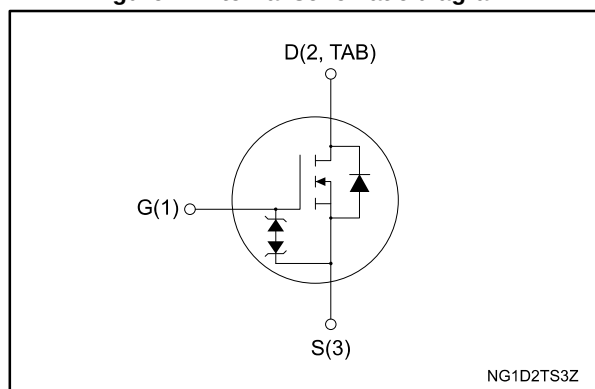


Figure 1: Internal schematic diagram

Description

This high voltage N-channel Power MOSFET is part of the MDmesh™ DM2 fast recovery diode series. It offers very low recovery charge (Q_{rr}) and time (t_{rr}) combined with low $R_{DS(on)}$, rendering it suitable for the most demanding high efficiency converters and ideal for bridge topologies and ZVS phase-shift converters.

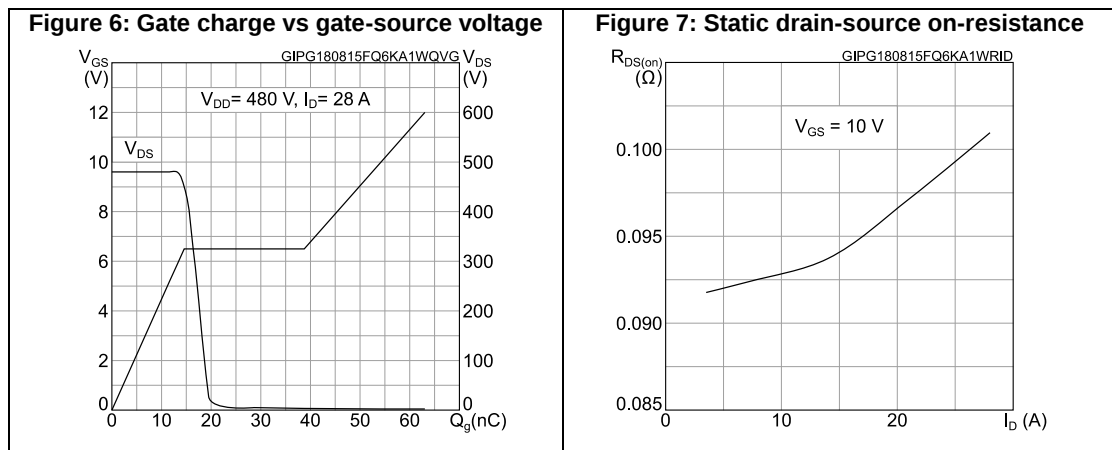
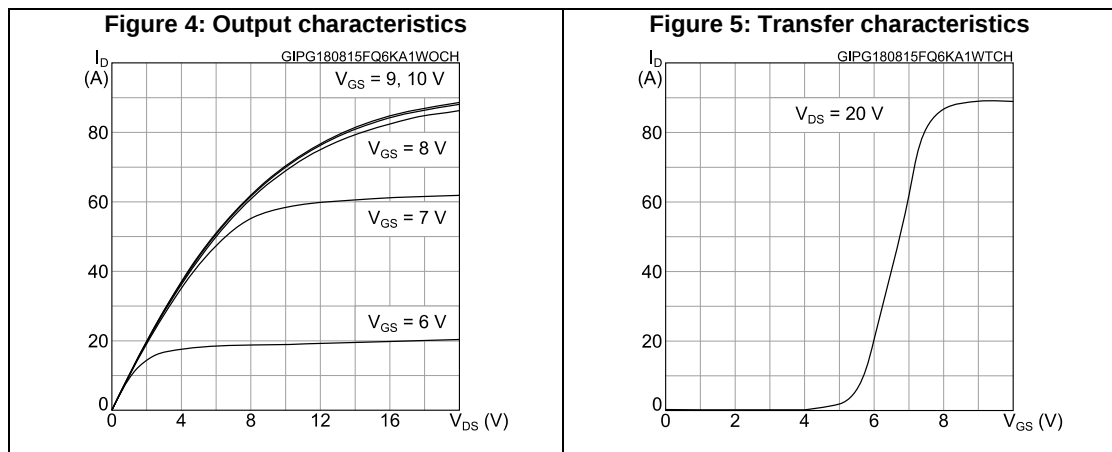
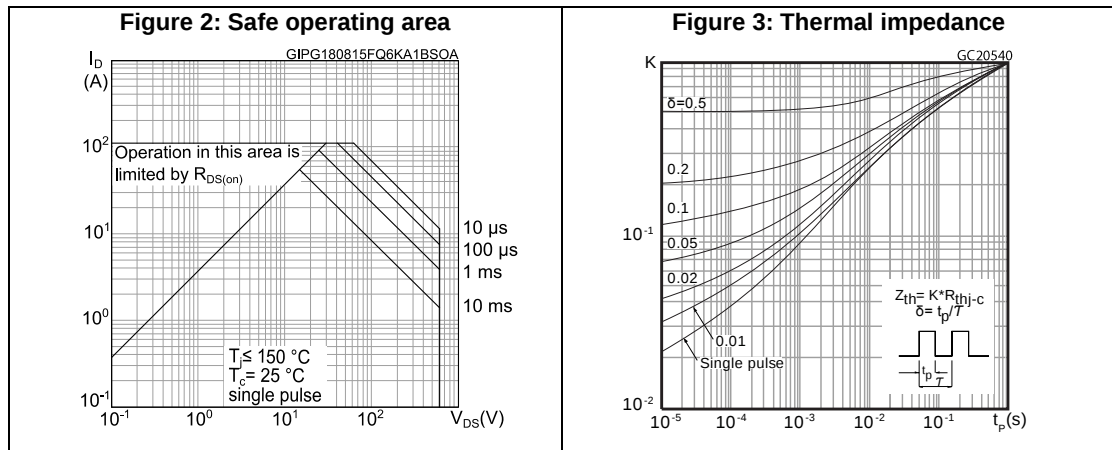


Figure 8: Capacitance variations

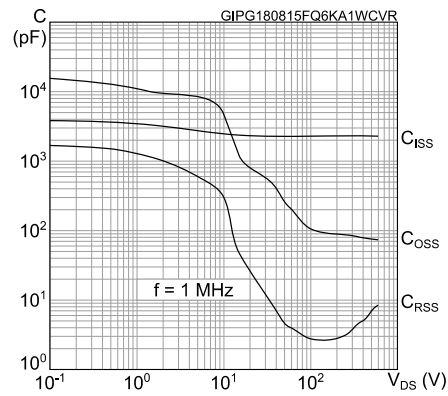


Figure 9: Normalized gate threshold voltage vs temperature

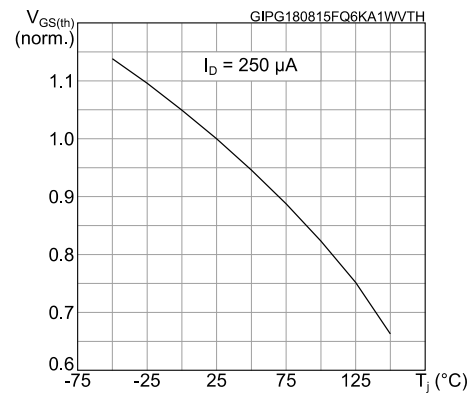


Figure 10: Normalized on-resistance vs temperature

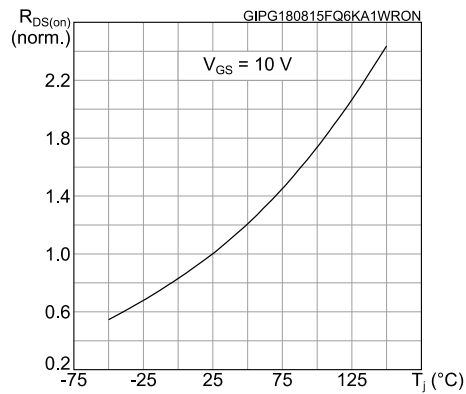
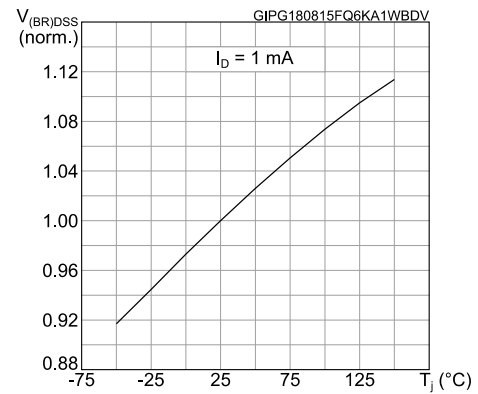
Figure 11: Normalized $V_{(BR)DSS}$ vs temperature

Figure 12: Output capacitance stored energy

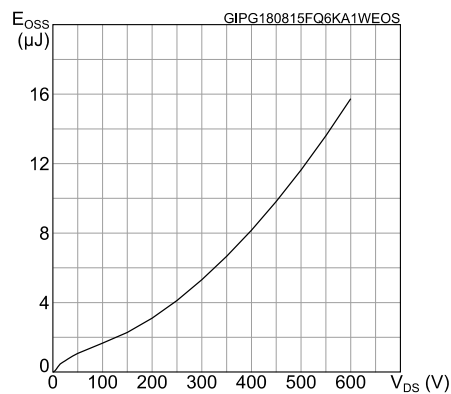
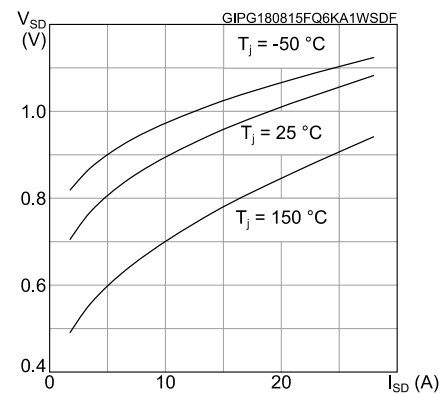


Figure 13: Source-drain diode forward characteristics

Figure 14: Test circuit for resistive load switching times

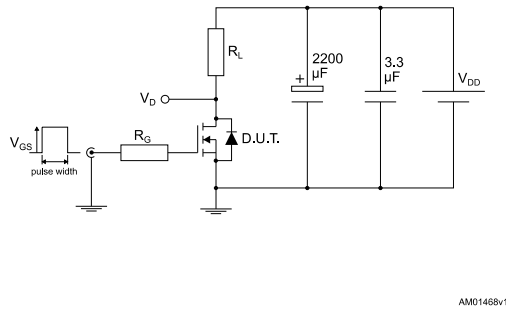


Figure 15: Test circuit for gate charge behavior

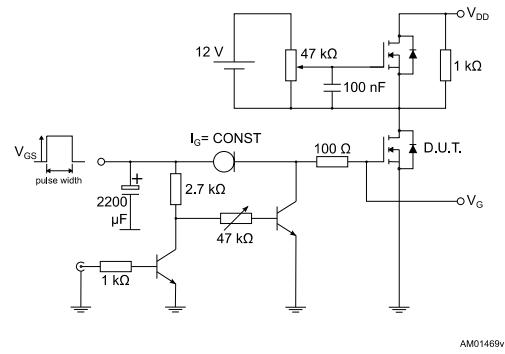


Figure 16: Test circuit for inductive load switching and diode recovery times

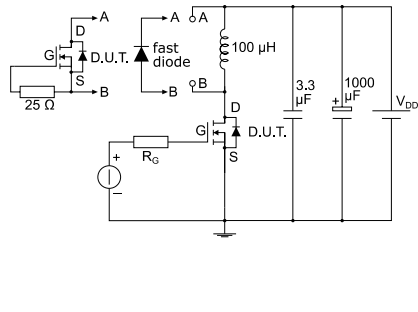


Figure 17: Unclamped inductive load test circuit

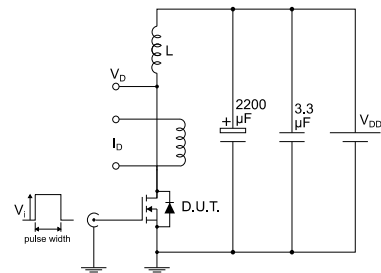


Figure 18: Unclamped inductive waveform

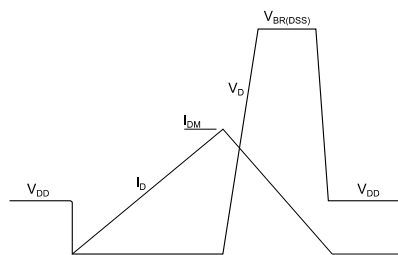
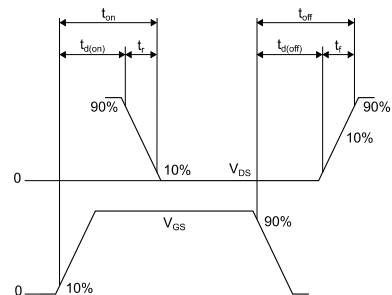


Figure 19: Switching time waveform

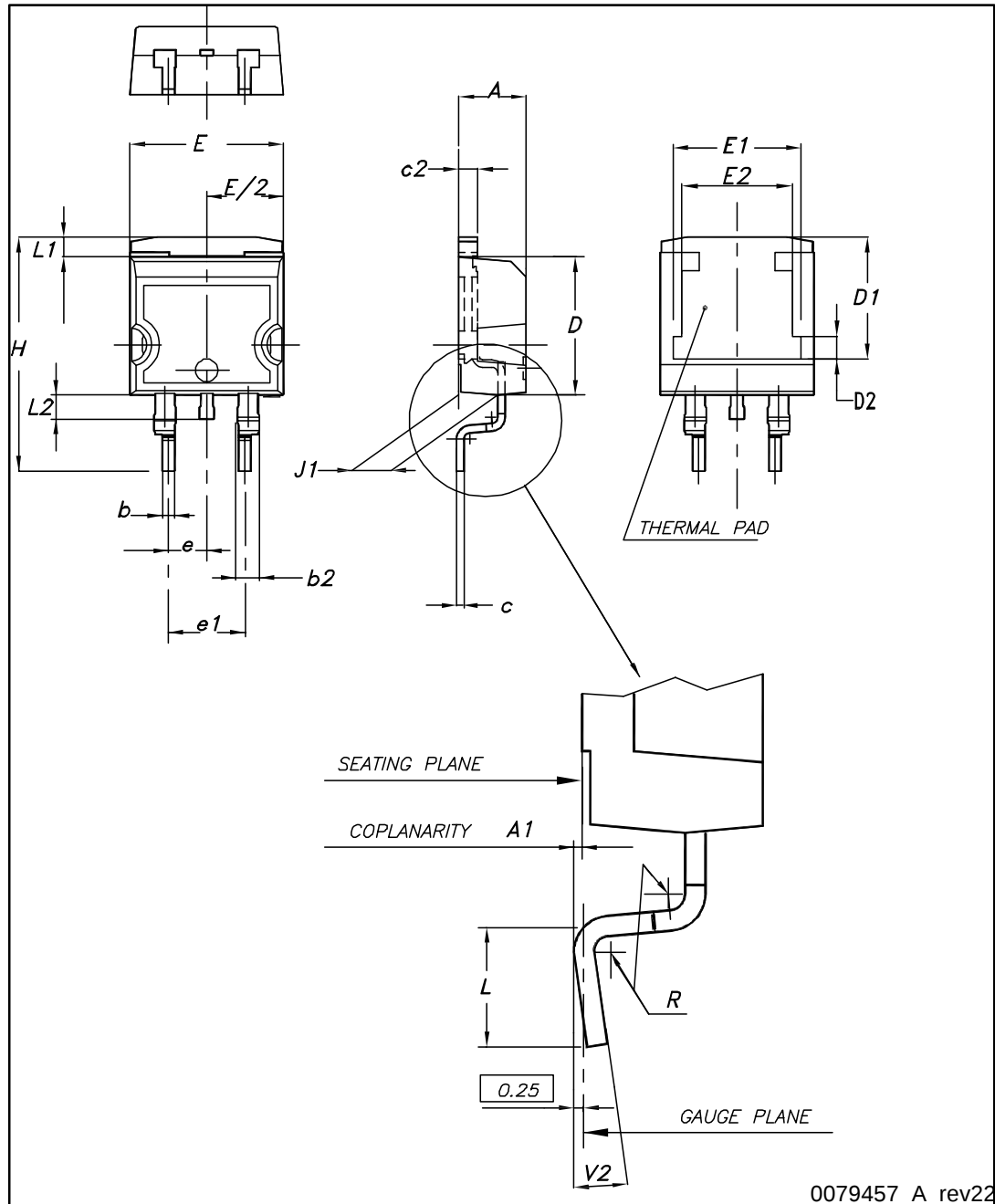

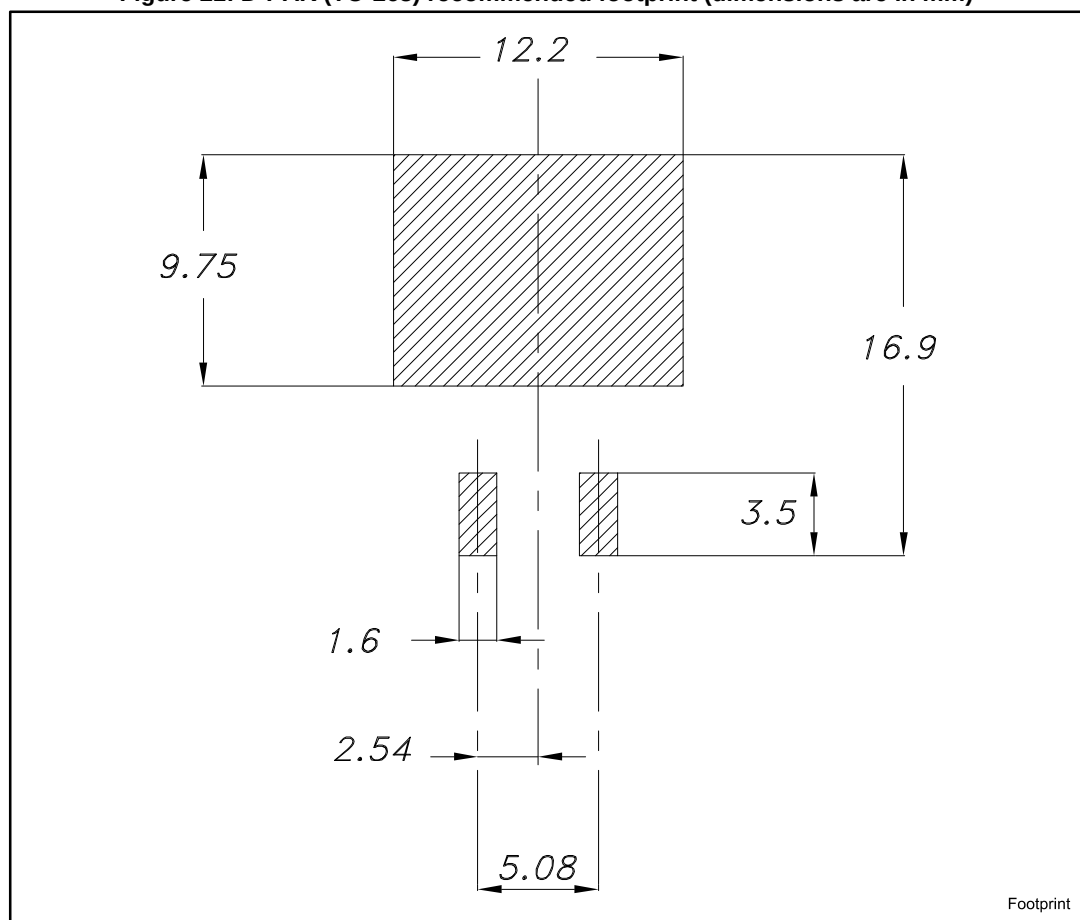
Figure 20: D²PAK (TO-263) type A package outline

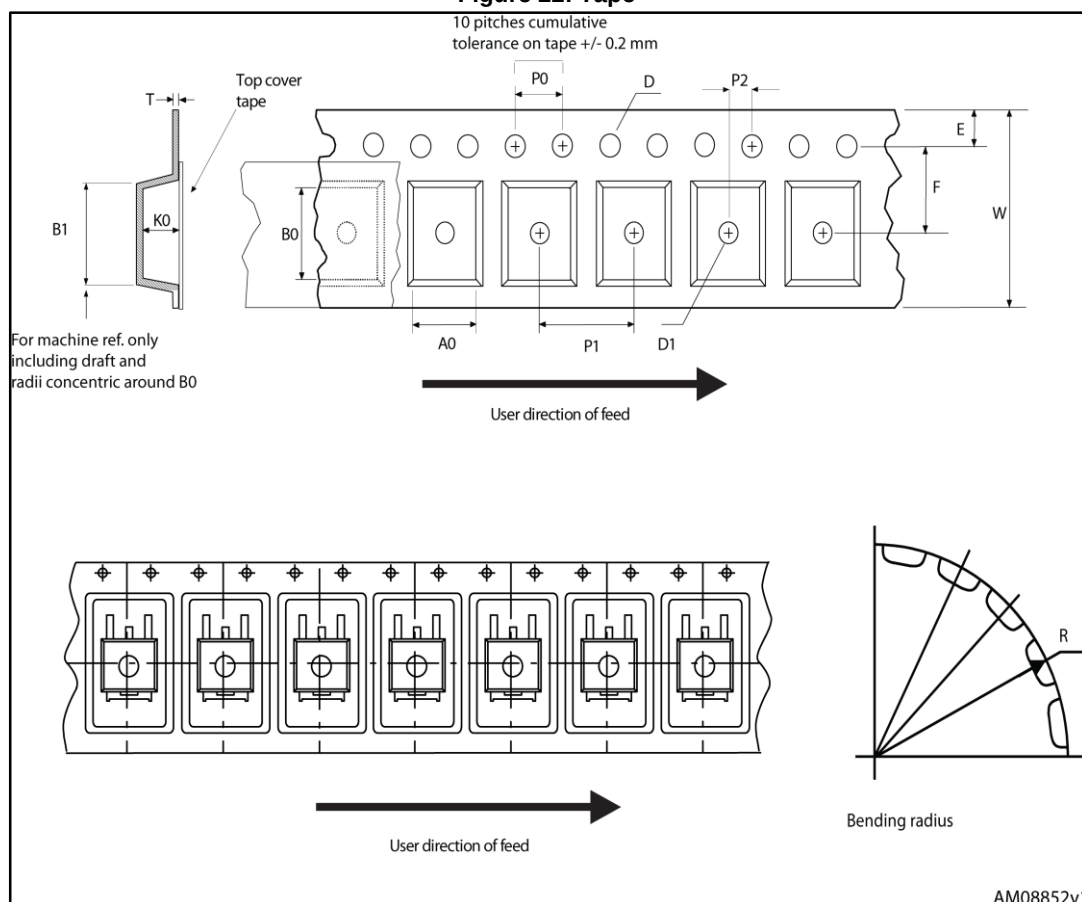
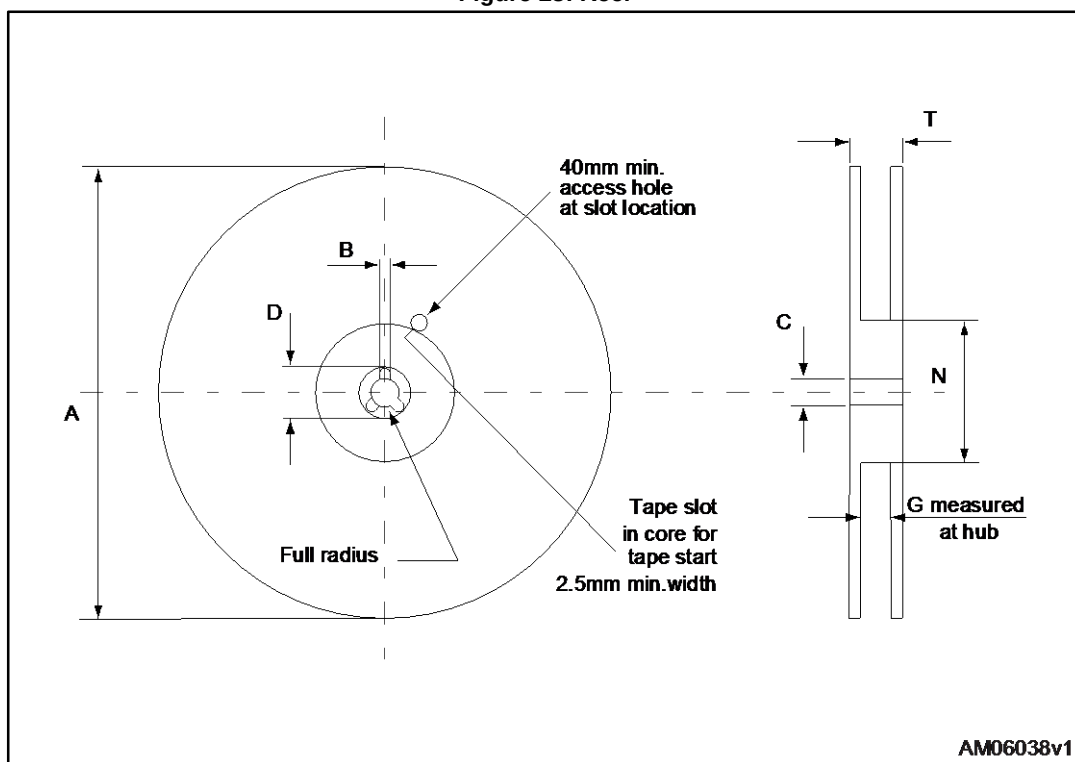


Figure 23: Reel
