








On-Resistance vs. Drain Current








On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature






On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



**Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature** 









Safe Operating Area


I<sub>DAV</sub> vs. Time

Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case


