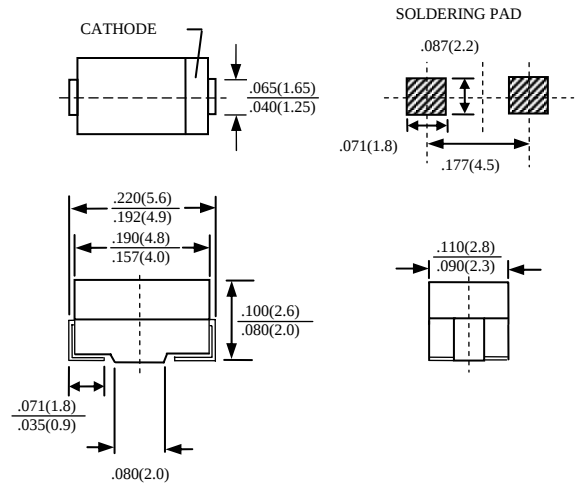

FIG. 1 - FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

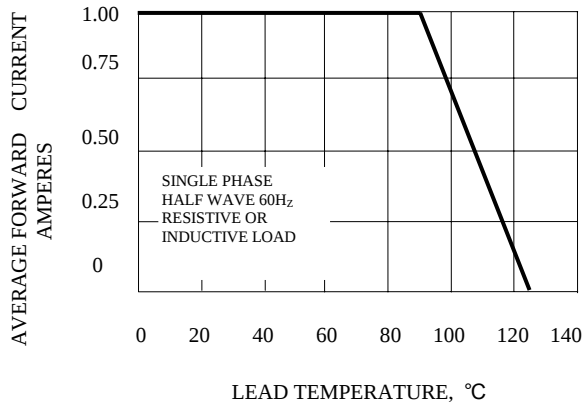


FIG. 2 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

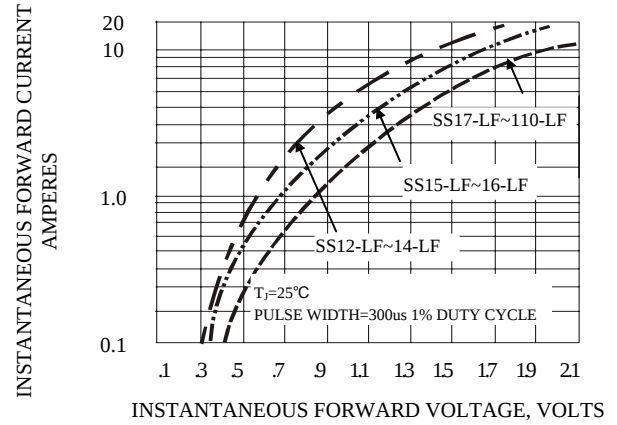


FIG. 3A - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

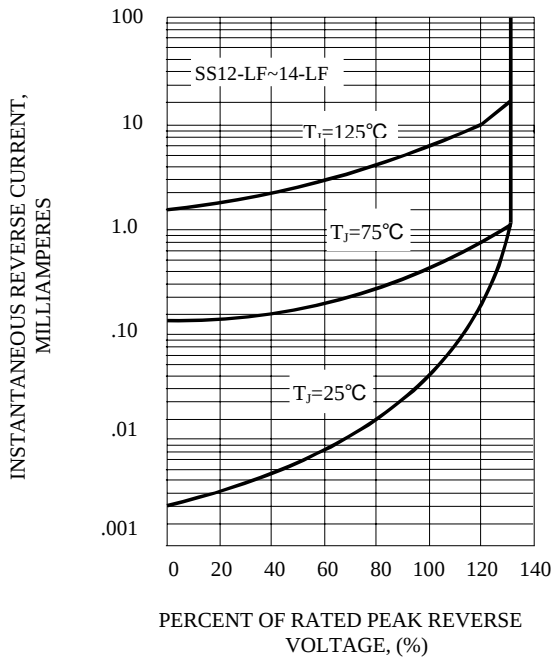


FIG. 3B - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
