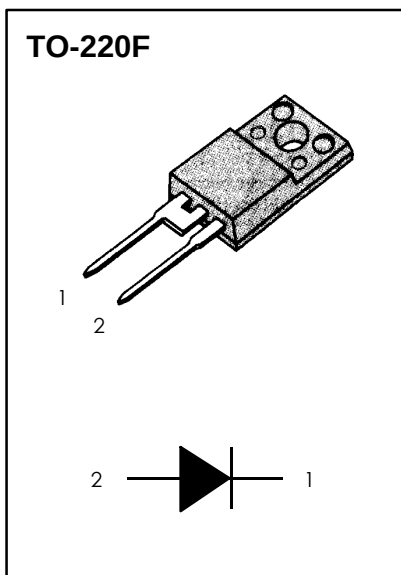

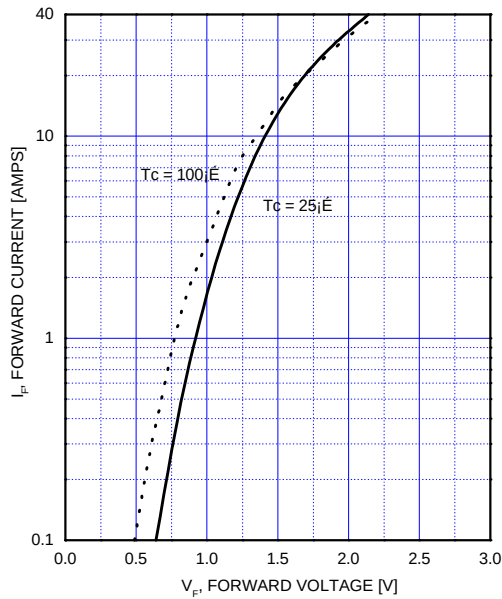


Fig.1 Typical Forward Voltage Drop vs. Forward Current

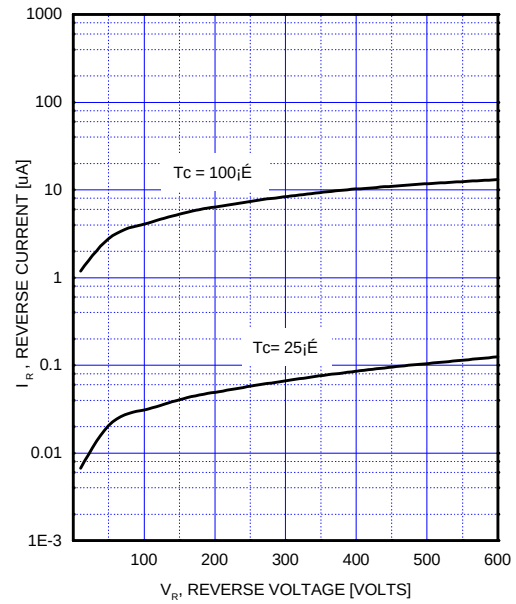


Fig.2 Reverse Voltage vs. Reverse Current

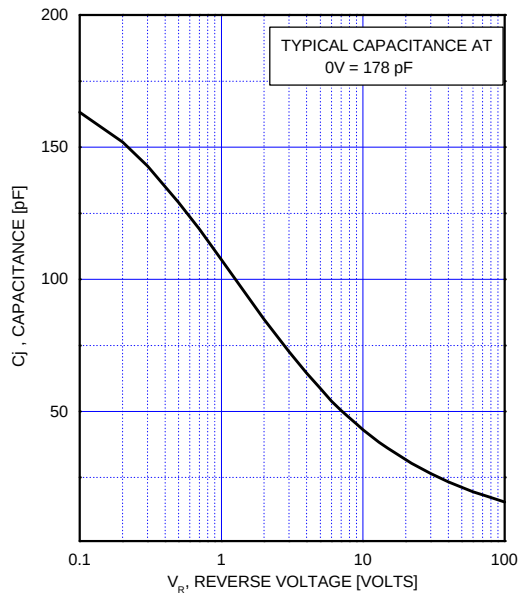


Fig.3 Typical Capacitance

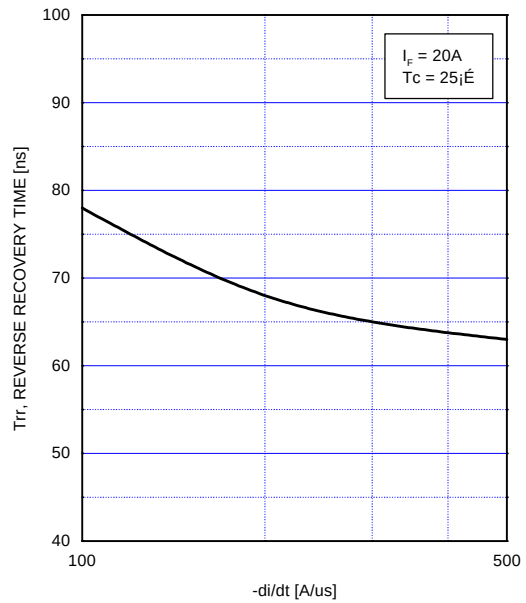


Fig.4 Typical Reverse Recovery Time vs. di/dt

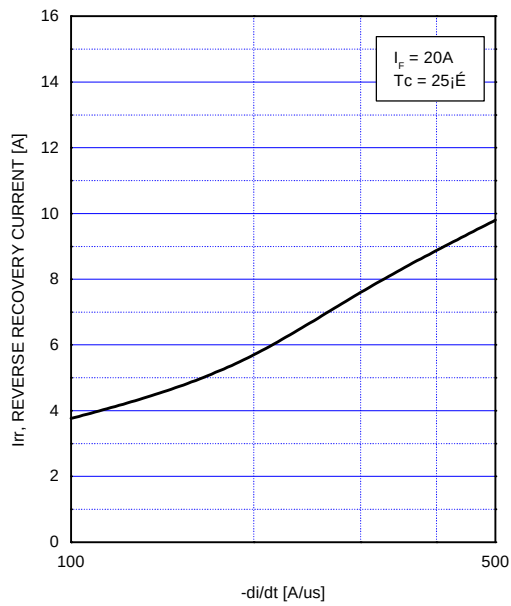


Fig.5 Typical Reverse Recovery Current vs. di/dt

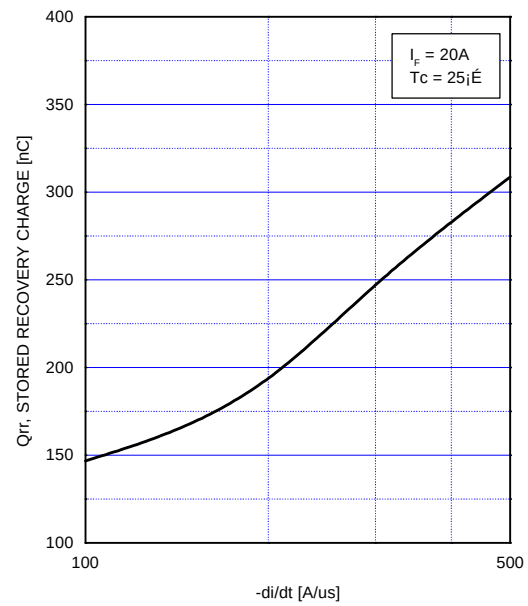
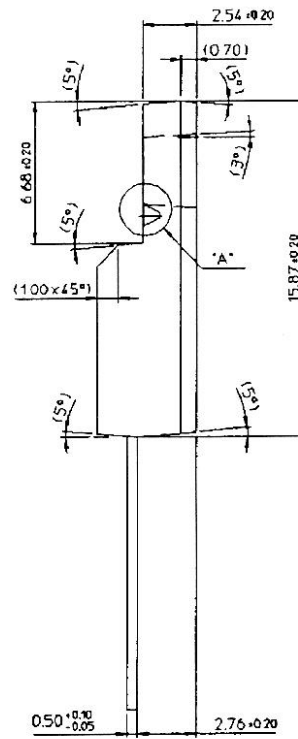
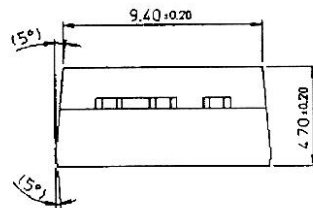
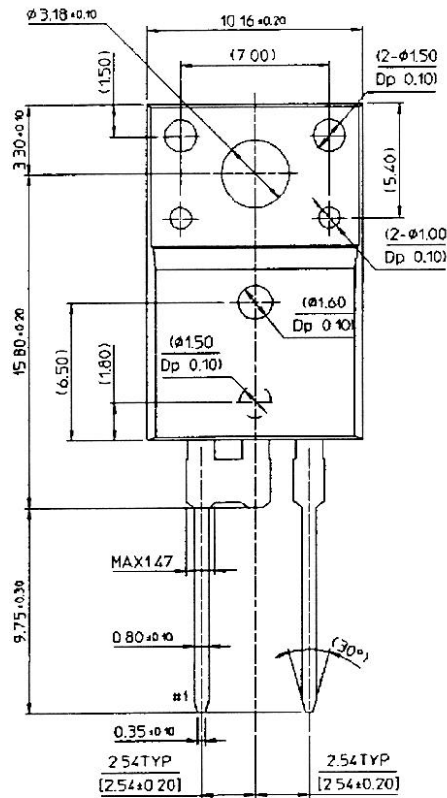


Fig.6 Typical Stored Charge vs. di/dt

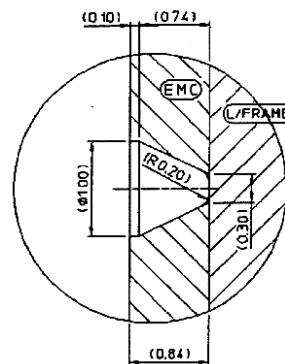
