


**Fig.1 On-Region Characteristics**




**Fig.2 On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage**




**Fig.3 On-Resistance Variation with Temperature**




**Fig.4 Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature**




**Fig.5 Transfer Characteristics**




**Fig.6 Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature**




**Fig.7 Gate Charge Characteristics**




**Fig.8 Capacitance Characteristics**




**Fig.9 Maximum Safe Operating Area**

**Fig.11 Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation**





**Fig.12 Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature**


